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内 容 提 要

本书针对中学生英语口语训练要求,从最基本的问答句着手,紧密结合英语新教材内容,分六大部分进行系统组编,分别通过综合性小对话、情景对话,引导学生进入情景问答操练,或编入小组进行集体练习,或进行课堂训练。为了提高学生的练习兴趣,编者还选编了部分内容生动、有趣、朗读上口的英语短剧,供学生课外模仿练习。

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前 言

《英语口语入门——俩俩分级对话读本》是张思中外语教学法丛书之一,它是根据"适当集中,反复循环,阅读原著,因材施教"的原则编写的。

本书共分6部分。

A 部分是 100 组综合性的小对话,均系日常生活中最常用的基本问答句,以供学生入门之用。

B 部分是按 25 个情景编写的对话。每个情景提供 4 组小对话,供学生根据情景分组进行课堂操练。

C部分是练习,供学生学完 25 个情景后进行又一轮的复习和操练。

D部分是问与答。通过一部分的学习,学生可以学会常用的问答用语,又可把前3部分学习的内容作再一次的集中与循环。

E 部分是短剧,供学生课外活动选用,以提高学习兴趣。

F 部分是词汇表,分别根据单词重读音节的音素归类和字母表顺序排列。

本书与国家教委颁布的新教材紧密联系,能使学生既学 到新的知识,又复习到课本中所学的内容。

本书由七宝中学澳大利亚籍教师 Bernice McKendry 和朱才龙老师审阅,在此特表谢意。

由于编写时间仓促,水平有限,疏漏和不足之处在所难免,希望广大读者提出批评和修改意见。
