编者的话

为了更好地发挥中专的评价和导向功能,更有针对性地帮助学生提高复习迎考的效率,减轻过重的复习负担,我们组织编写了2004年《初中复习导引英语分册》。

该书具有以下特点:

- 1.以教育部《关于初中毕业、升学考试的指导意见》和浙江省教育厅《关于2004年初中毕业、升学考试改革的指导意见》以及《义务教育全日制初级中学英语教育指导纲要》、《浙江省中考考试说明》为主要依据,并参考了中华人民共和国教育部《全日制义务教育英语课程标准》的有关内容,面向初三学生,提供适量的复习材料,帮助学生进行比较全面、系统的训练,提高听说读写能力。
- 2.全书分两部分:专项练习和附录。根据《浙江省中考考试说明》,把它分解成8个具体目标,每项目标均有解题方法指导,使复习目标更明白清楚。本书根据中考命题思路和题型要求精心选编试题,具有较强有力典型性、指导性和实用性。
- 3.本书中的"阅读理解"部分试题材料均来自课外,一般都是由英语原著改编,属于能力题,有一定的难度。试题中既有全国各地中考英语试题的典型题例,又有较多的开放性、探究性题目,供读者有较大的选择余地,方便使用。所有试题都附有参考答案。

编写一套供学生参考的学习用书是一件很不容易的事,责任重大,我们不敢怠慢。但鉴于编者水平有限,时间仓促,书中疏漏、不当之处在所难免,敬请广大读者批评、指正,以利于这套丛书进一步修订、完善。

Ⅱ、单项选择

单项填空主要是考核学生的基础语法知识,要求考生从四个选项中选出符合句意语法,表达得体的正确的选项。其特点是覆盖面广,知识点多,词汇量大。近几年来,此题型中,除了对基础语法、基本句型和习惯用法的考查外,还要求利用微型语境进行交际,以考查学生的语言交际能力。同时规定不要出语法难题、偏题。要解好单项填空题,不但要求学生熟练掌握英语基础知识,而且要注意语言运用和交际能力的培养,不需过多地钻语法难题。

单项填空题的解题步骤一般可分:(1)审题: 通读题干,弄清题意,初步确定答案范围,如: Hurry up! There's ____ time left. A. little B. a little C. few D. a few. 通读题干可知,这题缺少
