

出版说明

《走遍美国》(Family Album U. S. A.) 讲述了生活在纽约的斯图尔特(Stewart)一家三代的生活故事,通过教学节目中演员的出色表演,寓教于乐,妙趣横生,鲜活地展示了美国的风土人情和社会生活的方方面面。

全书采用"交际教学法",使学习者在实际场景中学习英语、培养其听说的运用能力、精心设计的练习又可帮助学习者提高读写水平、实在是不可多得的美语学习教材。因此、自1993年引入中国以来、《走遍美国》一直深受广大英语学习者的喜爱、得到广泛的好评。

进入新世纪,学习英语的热潮在中国日益蓬勃,英语学习者对于英语教程的要求也日益提高。为了适应新形势的要求,我们对原有教材的形式和结构进行了重新整理,推出这套《走遍美国》(全新版),希望帮助更多的学习者掌握美语,了解美国生活。

全书依然根据情节的发展进行结构安排。两册共26课,每课分为3幕。结构清晰,方便学习。学习者可以通过Useful Language一栏了解该幕将要学习的重点句型,进行学习前的"预热"。在学习课文的过程中,则可通过注释更好地理解课文。"美国生活点滴"提供了相应的文化背景介绍,解答学习者语言之外的疑惑。此外,Focus In部分对每课的关键句进行了归纳,有助于进一步巩固所学内容。课后丰富多样的练习(配有答案)则提供了更多的训练机会。在这样的精心编排下,即使没有VCD的学习者亦可独立自学。

此外,随两册主教材赠送辅导用书一本,提供课文译文、每课小结和词汇表,配合主教材使用,轻松方便。将译文与课文分开可以帮助学习者更好地在语境中进行理解,不受中文提示的影响,更好地锻炼个人能力。

希望《走遍美国》(全新版)能够给您提供更好的学习帮助,并祝愿广大英语学习者在英语学习的 路上越走越轻松!
