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第一章 名词和主谓一致

一、知识要点

①掌握可数名词与不可数名词;名词单数与复数的规则与不规则变化形式;②名词所有格的变化形式;③主谓一致的三个原则:语法一致、意义一致及就近原则,以及主谓一致应注意的几个问题。

二、重点难点

- 1. 不可数名词一般没有单复数之分,它包括抽象名词、物质名词和专有名词。
 - 2. 有关名词复数的不规则变化,请注意以下几点:
 - 1)一般以复数形式出现的名词。例如:

trousers, glasses(眼镜), clothes, goods(货物)

2)由 man 或 woman 等组成的复合名词变复数形式时,则前后两部分皆变为复数形式。例如:

man servant — men servants; woman doctor — women doctors; man cook — men cooks; woman singer — women singers

- 3. 有关名词的所有格,请注意以下几点:
- 1)如果一样东西为两个人共有,则只在后一个名词加"'s";如果不是共有的,两个名词后都要加"'s"。例如:

Jane and Mary's room (共有)

Jane's and Tom's books (不共有)

2) 起修饰作用的名词,如不表示所有关系,通常不用"'s"。例如:

room number, a tooth brush, coffee cup

4. 有关主谓一致问题,应遵循以下原则:

1) 语法形式上的一致。主语为单数形式,谓语动词用单数形式;主语为复数形式,谓语动词也用复数形式。用 and 或 both... and 连接并列主语,谓语动词通常用复数形式。

例如:

Plastics and rubber never rot.

Walking and riding are good exercises.

但是,并列主语如果指的是同一个人、同一事物或同一概念时, 谓语动词用单数形式,这时 and 后面的名词没有冠词。

例如:

Truth and honesty is the best policy.

The girl's teacher and friend is a young doctor.

Going to bed early and getting up early is a good habit.

A knife and fork is on the table.

当主语后面跟有 as well as, as much as, no less than, along with, with, like, rather than, together with, but, except, besides, including, in addition to 等引导的词组时,其谓语动词的单、复数按主语的单、复数而定。

例如:

The teacher as well as the students was excited.

The room with its furniture was rented.

2) 意义上一致。主语形式虽为单数,但意义为复数,谓语动词用复数。例如:

The crowd were running for their lives.

单数形式代表复数内容的词有:people,police,cattle 等。

主语形式为复数,而意义上却是单数,谓语动词用单数。例如:

The news was very exciting.

形式为复数而意义为单数的单词有 news, works(工厂)和一些以 ics 结尾的学科名称, physics, politics, economics 等。

3) 就近原则。即谓语动词的单、复数形式取决于最靠近它的词

语。如用连词 or, either... or, neither... nor, not only... but also 等连接的并列主语,如果一个是单数,一个是复数,谓语动词与靠近它的主语一致。例如:

Either your students or Mr Wang knows this.
