前言

对于非英语母语的人来说,随心所欲地运用英语表达自己的意见,往往非常困难。在用英语表达自己想法时,无意中会使用“I think ...”, What do you think ...?”这样的句型。但是,单凭这些,很难展开对话。毕竟总是重复使用同一英语表达模式,往往会令人厌烦。而现实生活中,大多英语学习者在打开话题这一点上,常常无所适从。

本书设定了从日常对话到商务谈判等多种表达自己想法的场景,并收集了1000条“陈述意见一句话”。除此以外,本书也收录有征求对方意见、确认其意图以及回应对

方提问等一系列表达方法,故本书可谓是一部惯用句型大全。与汉语相同,在用英语表达时,即使同一句话,都有直截了当和拐弯抹角两种方式。读者可以根据使用场合不同,灵活运用表达自己意见的说法。

本书适合于在重要场合难于开口,苦于无法用英语交换意见的读者。若本书能使读者朋友充满信心,对用英语表达意见有所裨益的话,笔者将不胜荣幸。

“What do you think about ... ?” 用来表示询问他人的观点。

“How do you think about ... ?” 和 “How do you feel about ... ?” 意为“你对……怎么看?” “what” 意为“什么”, “how” 意为“怎么”。“How do you think about ... ?” 和 “How do you feel about ... ?” 可以表达同样的意思。

views (on): 观点; reaction (to): 反应; feelings (about) : 感想。

How would you react to-ing ... ?

How would you react to replacing our sales manager?

你对更换我们的销售经理有何看法?

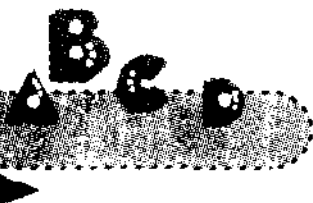

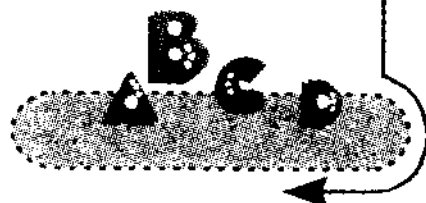

“Don't you think ... ?”是比较尊重他人的一种反问方式。

“You don't think ... !”则表示了一种对立的态度。

How did it grab you?

I just read Henry's speech draft.

我刚刚读过亨利的演讲稿。

How did it *grab* you? I know he spent a lot of time on it.

对它的印象如何?我觉得他在那上面花了大量时间。

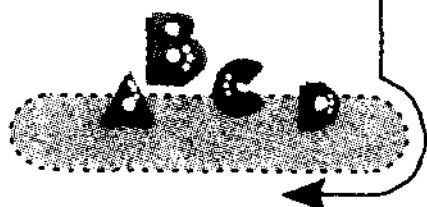

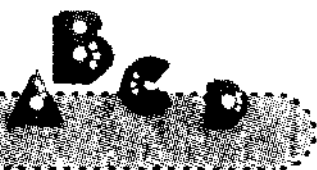

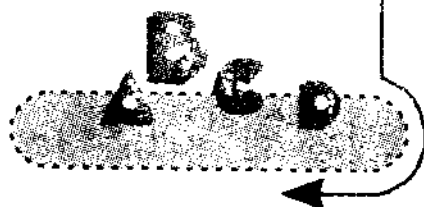
