美国的中学教育实在精彩，然而笑笑的父母却让她回国，是因为在美国的中学里，也存在许多无奈和遗憾！

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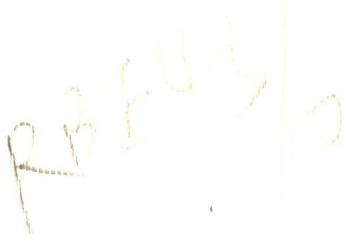


该书稿获得 2000 年全国首届“花季雨季”全国征文大赛创作金奖

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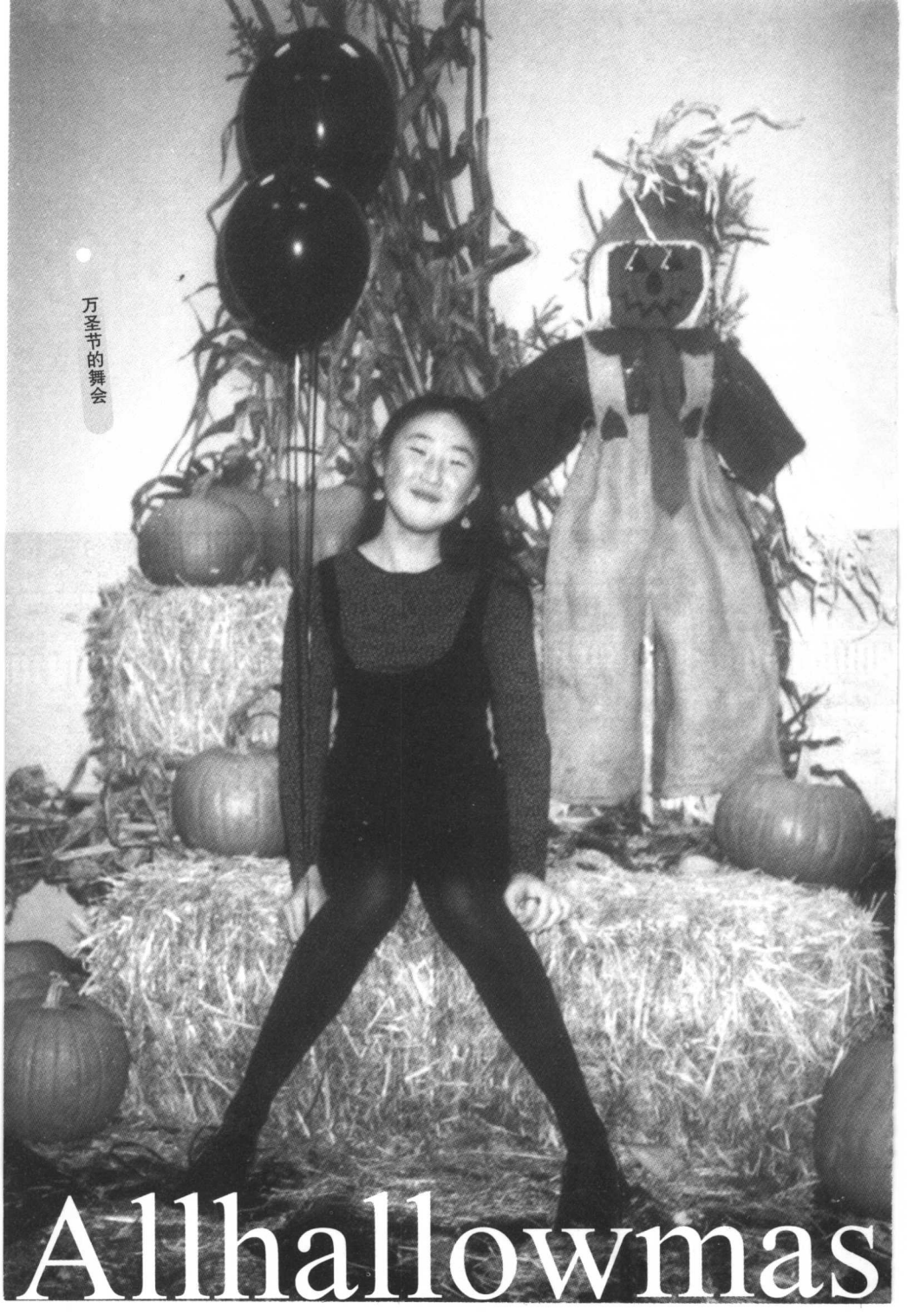
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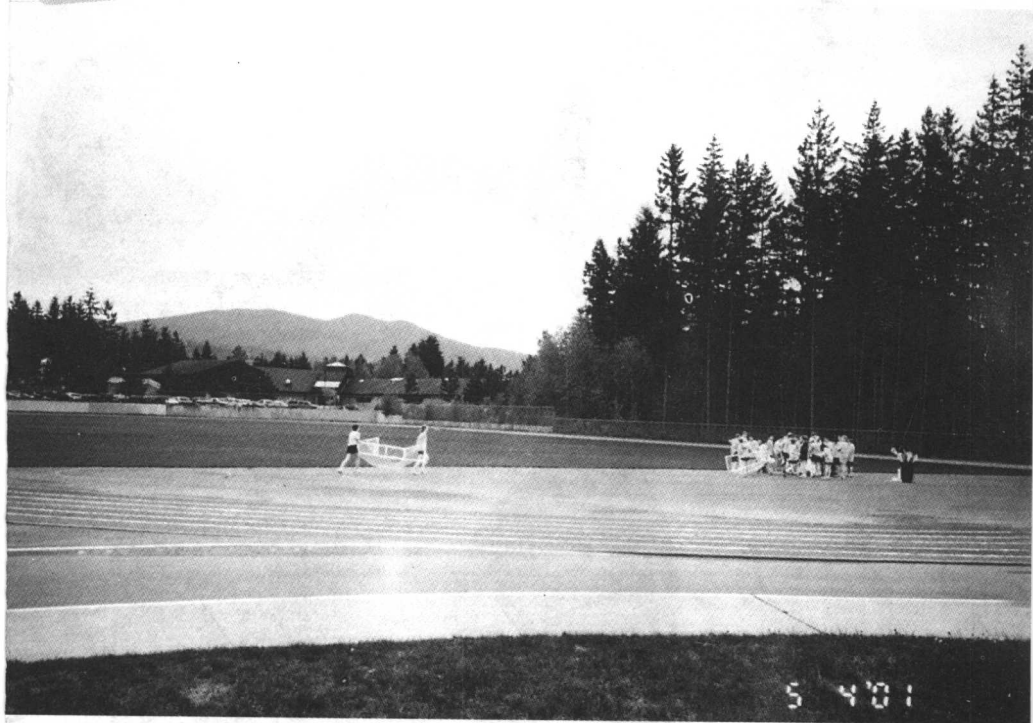

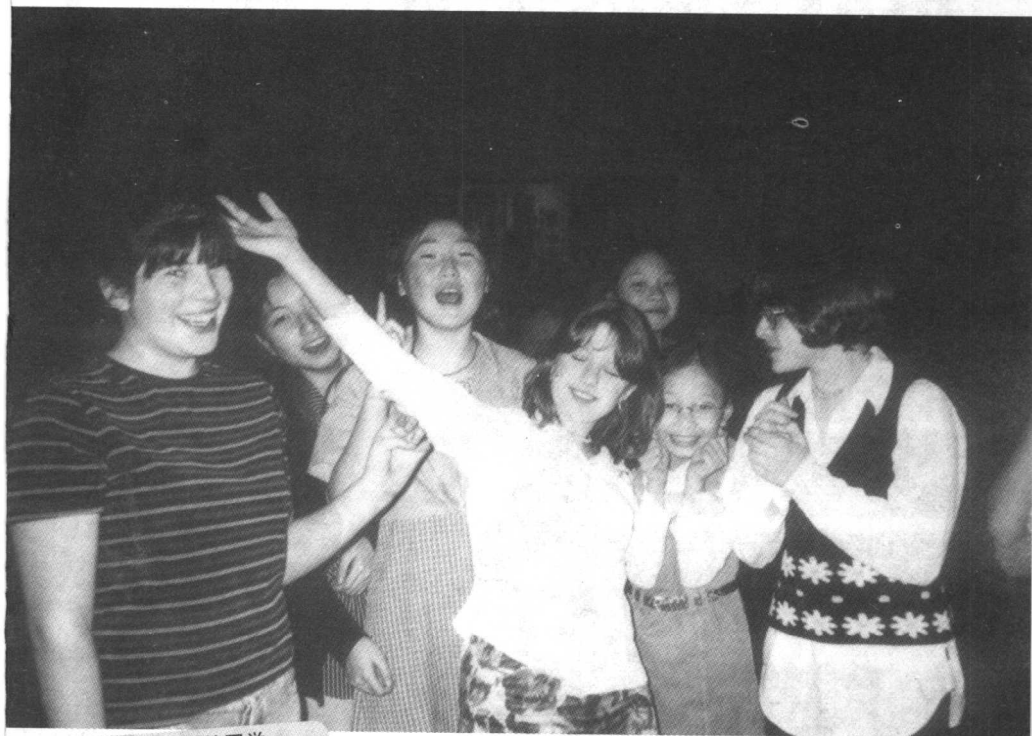
