本书编写的主要目的是通过大量的模拟训练和详细而重点突出的讲解,帮助英语专业本科初级阶段的学生融会贯通地掌握语法知识、扩大词汇量。

本书有以下两个突出特点:

一、紧扣《大纲》,突出重点。本书严格按照最新修订的《高校英语专业四级考试大纲》和《高等学校英语专业基础阶段英语教学大纲》对语法与词汇的题型、难度和范围的要求编写而成,其题型设置、重点难点的分布和覆盖范围与大纲提供的样题和历年考试真题保持一致。我们在选材时,既考虑到难度适中,覆盖面广,又兼顾到重点难点语法和词汇的重现率。另外,我们也收录了一部分往年的全真考题,我们在这部分考题后加上了"[TEM: ××××年]"字样。

二、详尽解析,精彩译文。本书精解部分的目的是使考生知其然又知其所以然,因此对语法题的解释重点列举同一类语法现象及解题要略,并给出例句加以说明。对词汇题的详解部分则以详为本,除给出各选项的词义之外,一般还根据需要通过例句说明其用法、固定搭配以及与其同义词的区别。为了帮助读者对题干更好地理解与把握,我们给出了题干的参考译文。

本书作者近年来一直从事山东大学英语专业二年



级《综合英语》的教学工作以及专业四级考试的具体组织和主要辅导工作,积累了丰富的教学和辅导经验,所负责辅导的英语专业本科生的及格率在1995~2001年的全国英语专业四级考试中均在95%以上,成绩在全国一直名列前茅。作者的这些经验和经历也决定了本书的高质量。

由于编写时间仓促,编者水平有限,书中难免有不当之处,恳请广大读者和同行专家批评指正。
