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前 言

《新视野大学英语助学手册》是一套旨在帮助学生学习的《新视野大学英语》的辅助教材。本书以《新视野大学英语读写教程》(第三册)中的课文为蓝本,以《大学英语教学大纲》为依据,精心挑选出课文的重点词、短语、结构以及难句,并就其含义、用法进行了详细的注释和适当的引申。目的在于通过例句、讲解、练习等形式,一方面使学生能较为全面地了解所学课文的语言点,使更多的只知其意的消极词汇(Passive Words)变为能活学活用的积极词汇(Active Words);另一方面在牢固掌握的基础上逐渐地融会贯通,并进而有效地扩展知识面。

本书由以下几部分组成:

第一部分 学前预测(20道选择题)

第二部分 课文重点、难点助学

Key Words 从课文中挑选部分重点词汇进行注释、讲解、引申,并附有[例句]、[派生词]、[考与记]、[同义词辨析]等,使学生既能掌握词汇的不同义项和用法,又能较快地扩大词汇量,在联想和比较中了解词与词之间的细微差别,达到触类旁通、举一反三的效果。

Key Phrases and Expressions 从课文中挑选部分词组和惯用法,展开联想、说明,通过实例,使学生既掌握了课文中出现的词组,又接触到与之相关的大量词组和惯用法。

Key Structures 将课文中出现的英语中常用的句式结构予以点拨,使学生了解英语句式结构的精髓和奥妙。

Difficult Sentences 将课文中学生较难理解的句子单列出来,进行语言点和语法分析,深入浅出,易懂易记。

第三部分 补充练习 (20道选择题、2篇阅读理解、1篇完形填空或简短问题回答、5句翻译和一段英译中等)

第四部分 课文部分练习题参考答案

第五部分 课文参考译文

本书每单元的[学前预测]和[补充练习]中的所选材料是根据《大学英语教学大纲》和《大学英语四、六级考试大纲》的要求设计的。一方面让学生掌握好课文的主要内容,不断提升语言素质,提高语言运用能力;同时又让学生熟悉大学英语四、六级考试的题型,并在较高的要求下富有成效地学习,提高学生的应试能力。

1. fantastic [fæn'tæstɪk]

a. 1) *very good; excellent* 极好的, 极出色的

She is a fantastic swimmer. 她游泳游得非常好。

— I've passed my driving test. — Fantastic!

— 我通过了驾驶员考试。 — 好极了!

2) (*of ideas, plans, etc.*) *too unrelated to reality to be practical or reasonable; absurd* 异想天开的, 不切实际的; 难以置信的

Your proposals are utterly fantastic, and we couldn't possibly afford them.

你的那些建议太不切实际了, 我们不可能实现得了。

The truth is so fantastic that all the people can't believe it.

事实真相是那么离奇以至于所有的人都不相信它。

3) *odd, strange, or wild in shape, meaning, etc.* 奇异的, 古怪的



I had a fantastic dream last night. 昨晚我做了一个奇怪的梦。

4) (*informal*) *very large, extraordinary* 极大的,多得惊人的

Their wedding cost a fantastic amount of money. 他们的婚礼花费了很大一笔钱。

They made a fantastic profit on this business. 他们在这笔生意上发了大财。

2. suspicion [sə'spiʃən]

n. 1) *a belief or feeling that sth. is wrong or that sb. has done wrong* 猜疑,怀疑

They looked at each other with suspicion. 他们怀疑地互相看着对方。

I have the suspicion that he is not telling me the truth. 我怀疑他没有对我讲实话。

2) (*a*) *belief that a crime is committed or that sb. is guilty of sth.* 怀疑,嫌疑

He was arrested on suspicion of having stolen the money.

他因涉嫌偷那笔钱而被逮捕。

Suspicion falls on their neighbors. 疑点落在他们的邻居身上。

3. arouse [ə'rauz]

Her strange behavior aroused our suspicion. 她不寻常的举动引起了我们的猜疑。

They succeeded in arousing the nation's sympathy. 他们已经激起了全民的同情。

It may arouse his interest in the subject. 这也许能激起他对这门学科的兴趣。

2) *wake (sb.) from sleep* 唤醒

He was aroused from his nap by the doorbell. 他午睡时被门铃吵醒。

4. mislead [mis'li:d]

They were misled into buying a car. 他们受误导买了一辆汽车。

You misled me as to your intention. 你使我误解了你的意图。

2) *lead or guide in the wrong direction* 领错或引错方向

We were misled by the guide and almost lost our way. 我们被向导带错了方向,几乎迷了路。

3) *cause to be or do wrong* 把……带坏,使误入歧途

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Make sure your children are not misled by bad companions.
务必不要让你的孩子被坏伙伴带坏。

2) *bring sb./sth. back to a former position or condition* 使恢复,使回复

He had his vision restored by surgical operation. 外科手术使他恢复了视力。

This generous action restored my faith in human being.

这种慷慨行为使我恢复了对人的信任。

He was restored to his post. 他官复原职。

3) *give back (sth. lost) to its owner* 归还,交还

The police restored more than 300 stolen bikes to their owners.

警方把300多辆自行车归还给了失主。

同义词辨析

restore 修复,恢复,指用他力使某东西回到它原来的位置或恢复它原来的样子。主要用于建筑物和艺术品的修复或修缮,常用被动语态。

The relations between the two countries were restored to normal.

两国间的关系恢复了正常。

The temple has been restored out of recognition.

这座庙宇经过整修已经让人认不出来了。

recover 恢复,康复,痊愈,强调用自己的力量来恢复原状。多指身体、健康、情绪、财物、领土、自由等的恢复。

He has recovered from his illness. 他已经恢复健康。

He was very upset but recovered himself in time to make a speech.

他心里非常紧张,但还是及时地使自己恢复常态发表讲话。

resume 恢复,继续,强调重新开始中断的事。

The travelers resumed their journey after a short break.

短暂休息之后,旅行者又上路了。

The government resumed control over the area. 政府重新控制了该地区。

6. estate ['esteit]

n. 1) a large area of land in country which is owned by a family or an organization and is often farmed 庄园, 大片私有土地

He owned a large estate in Scotland. 他在苏格兰有一个很大的庄园。

The colonel returned to his estate near Oxford for the weekend.

上校回到了他牛津附近的庄园度周末。

2) all the money and property that a person owns, esp. which is left at death 财产(尤指遗产); 地产

Her estate was divided among her four children. 她的遗产分给了她的四个子女。

He is a real estate agent. 他是一位房地产经纪人。

7. auction ['ɔ:kʃən]

n. a usually public sale of goods or property, where people make higher and higher offers of money for each item, until it is sold to the person who will pay the highest price 拍卖, 拍卖会

The big house will be sold by auction. 这所房子将被拍卖。

It should be sold for \$ 100,000 at auction. 拍卖它可得 100 000 美元。

vt. sell sth. by auction 拍卖

They are going to auction the pictures at the end of the month. 他们将在月底拍卖这些画。

8. horizon [hə'raɪzən]

Smooth seas are stretching from horizon to horizon. 平静的海面无边无际。

2) (pl.) the limit of a person's knowledge, experience, interest, etc. 一个人的知识、经验、兴趣的限度或范围; 眼界; 见识

These issues are beyond their own horizons. 这些问题超出了他们自身的知识范围。

The latest government figures on inflation show some bright rays on the national economic horizons.

政府最近公布的通货膨胀数字使人看到国家经济状况的一线曙光。

She is a woman of narrow horizons. 她是一位眼界狭小的女子。

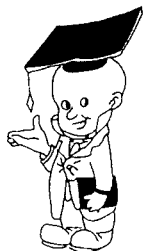

This shop furnishes everything that is needed for camping.

We furnished him with the necessary fund for his scientific research.

我们向他提供了科研所必需的资金。

provide 强调免费提供所需的东西。

The company provided him with a car. 公司提供给他一辆汽车。

The management will provide food and drink. 管理部门将供应饮料和食品。

supply 指不断地、定期地提供或供应所需的东西。
 Germany is supplying much of the steel for the new pipeline.

11. deposit [di'pɔ:zɪt]

 2) *pay as a part of a large sum, the rest of which is to be paid later* 付(定金)
 He deposited 2,000 yuan on a new car. 他先付 2 000 元作为购置新车的定金。

 I have been commissioned to write a new play. 我受委托写一部新剧本。
 He was commissioned (as) a general. 他被任命为将军。
n. 1) *a group of people who have been formally chosen to find information about a problem or carry out a task* 考察团;调查团;委员会
 The government has set up a commission to investigate the problem of inner city violence.
 政府成立了一个委员会来调查市中心暴力问题。
 A royal commission is reporting on betting and gambling.
 由英王委派的调查团正在调查赌博一事。
 2) *an action, task or piece of work given to sb. to do* 任务,委托
 She has received many commissions to design public buildings.
