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前 言

学习英语,有了一定的语法基础之后,最难掌握的便是词汇的用法问题,能否对词汇的用法有较好的掌握,是能否学好英语的关键所在。

在英语词汇中,动词一般是句子的核心。正确理解、掌握和运用英语动词及其短语十分重要,是中国人学习英语的难点之一。学习好动词的用法对正确地去表达思想,理解句意有着很大作用。因此,一部切实可用的英语动词用法词典是每一个英语工作者及英语学习者必不可少的工具书,所以我们根据许多人学习和运用英语动词时常感到迷惑的问题或常犯的错误编写了这本《英语常用动词搭配词典》。

本词典以英语动词为词目,共收集绝大部分常用或较常用的动词共三千余条,其中也不乏有一些不常用的动词,因其搭配关系特殊,我们也一并收入。读者使用本词典将有助于提高用词、造句、作文的能力,少走弯路,对正确使用动词,从而正确使用英语,将会收到事半功倍的效果。

何谓搭配?搭配就是一个词与其它词或句子之间的组合。英语和汉语中词的搭配有很多不同点。如汉语中“开车、开门、开刀、开灯”都用“开”,但英语中却分别要用“drive、open、operate、turn on”与后接名词搭配。即便是同一个单词如 advise,也会由于要表达的意思不同或句子结构不同等原因而采用不同的搭配,如:advise an early start; advise waiting till 11 o'clock; advise him to give up smoking; advise that he should go there at once。有些学习者可能觉得这么多用法过于繁琐、不易掌握。其实通过分析和规纳我们可以从表面的复杂性、无序性中找到其中的规律性、有序性。仍以 advise 为例,我们可以总结出它在句中几种不同的搭配形式:advise + *n.*; advise + *pron.*; advise + *v.*-ing; advise sb. + to do sth.; advise + *cl.*等等。

本词典所选动词按字母顺序排列。词后没有直接用汉语释义,而是通过短语及例句释义。目的在于让读者通过语境理解语义,避免孤立地背单词。一般顺序是词目及动词类别(*vt.*或*vi.*),词目以下,介绍动词的搭配关系。其中用“~”符号代替该动词,用缩略语代表各种词类、词形或从句

等。动词搭配主要体现了如下句子结构类型:

本词典对各种搭配关系都分别进行了举例说明。为了压缩篇幅,举例一般使用短语或短句。有些短语不能说明问题的,则以例句加以说明。

本词典适合于大、中学生,英语自学者以及其他英语爱好者使用,也可作为英语教师的教学参考用书。

在编写过程中,我们参阅了近年来国内外出版的多种词典、大中学校教科书以及有关的英语语言刊物,从而充实并丰富了本书的内容。

由于编者水平有限,本词典不足之处在所难免,诚恳希望读者提出宝贵意见。
