



本书是在参考国外编写的常用词词表的基础上,根据教育部对英语教学的最新要求编写的一本集实用性、应用型为一体的考试型、原创性词语搭配词典,旨在帮助学生更好地掌握、运用词语,适应新的考试重点。如短语 a military advisor to the President,其重点不是放在 adviser或 advisor上,也不是在 president上,而是在 to 上。教师教词汇,更要教用法,而用法往往体现在搭配上。笔者在学校、社会上的英语四、六级,考研等的辅导、命题以及阅卷中发现:由于学生对英语词汇前、后搭配掌握情况的不理想而导致选择的失分、表达的失误或考试的失败。为此,特将多年来的经验积累、素材收集编写成此小词典,以切实帮助各类考生掌握常用的词语搭配。本小词典还有以下一些特色:

- 1. 所列词条点出其常用的介词搭配,学生可以从所 提供的例句中看出其区别。具有很强的可看性。
- 2. 所列词条覆盖面广,它概括了英语、非英语专业学生要接触到的大多数词条,能有效地帮助学生掌握词语的应用。具有很强的前瞻性。
- 3. 每一词条都精选了相关的例句,以说明其用法。 在有些容易引起误解的地方,进一步提供例句,加以辨别。 具有很强的参考性。
- 4. 编排新颖、务实,携带方便,学生可以随时拿出来翻翻、记记,以达到事半功倍的效果。具有很强的利用性。

本小词典的例句一部分选自于各类试卷,一部分选自 各类教材和自己的教案,一部分选自于最新的报刊杂志, 同时也参阅了相关的词典。虽经斟酌再三,但错误之处唯 恐难免,敬请不吝赐教。参加本小词典编写的还有钟亮、
