谈如何备考雅思口语 (自序)

一、雅思口语评分标准

1. 内容

流利、与问题相关,并尽量新颖、有趣。

2. 语言

使用较广泛的词汇,较丰富的句型,尽可能减少语法错误。

3. 发音

正确、清楚,并尽量优美、地道。

4. 气质

口语是雅思四项考试中惟一和考官面对面交流的一项,考生最好能以迷人的气质将对方击倒,让他(她)非给你7分不可。

二、如何备考雅思口语

1. 熟悉雅思口语考试的要求和注意事项

如考试分几部分,每部分的内容和时间,评分标准,考试时注意些什么等。阅读本书 第一章,就可以得到这些问题的全部答案。

2. 熟悉雅思口语考试常考的题目并事先做好准备

雅思口语考试常考的题目,基本是固定的。在考试前熟悉它们,并准备好回答,是考试取得成功的关键。本书第二章介绍了第一部分常考问题。第三章介绍了第二部分常考卡片及第三部分常考问题。第四章分类给出了准备答案常用的词汇。第五章分类给出了准备答案的参考素材。第六章汇集了部分参加过雅思口语考试的同学的考试过程回忆。阅读这些内容,对大家备考雅思会有帮助。

3. 多做练习

和外教或口语较好的人针对雅思口语考试常考的题目做练习,并请他们指出你的错误和不足。自己也可以和自己做练习,有时可以用录音机将自己的回答录下来,自己检查。

4. 经常上网,了解雅思口语考试的最新信息

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一、雅思口语考试概述

1. 雅思考试概述

问: 什么是 IELTS 考试?

国际英语水平测试(The International English Language Testing System)可以在世界超过 100 个不同的国家参加。它专门为准备进入以英语教学的学院或大学深造的学生进行英语水平测试而设。IELTS 国际英语水平测试由英国剑桥大学测试中心(The University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicat – UCLES)、澳大利亚高校国际开发署(IDP Education Australia)及英国文化委员会(The British Council)共同举办。1990 年 4 月在中国开始推广。

则是为留学生而设。因雅思考试有口语项目,因此会比 TOEFL 更具有可信度。培训类(General Training Module)的阅读和写作部分的要求比学术类(Academic Module)中的要英国、澳大利亚、新西兰、加拿大以及许多国家的众多院校均采用并认可这一语言测试系统。加拿大、澳大利亚、新西兰等国家的移民局均将这种考试成绩作为技术移民及其他类移民中衡量英语语言能力的惟一标准。以上国家的学校和培训进修项目及许多国家的院校都接受这一考试成绩,并设立不同的成绩合格标准。

IELTS 考试分培训类(General Trianing Module)和学术类(Acadmic Module)两类。培训类是为移民而设,而学术类求相对较低,但听力和口试部分则与学术类(Academic Module)相同。

问:考试时间为多长?

考试时间为 2 小时 55 分钟;考试包含四个部份,分别为听力、阅读、写作和口语。 雅思考试一般安排在周六和周日两天。考试的流程如下:

周六上午,一定按要求8:15到达考场,不能迟到。

8:15-9:00 人场

9:00-9:40 听力

9:45-10:45 阅读

10: 45-11: 45 写作

口语安排在周六下午和周日。

注意:上面只是通常情况下的安排,极少数情况下有例外,以考场通知为准。

问: 我什么时候可以知道我的考试成绩?

一般来说,你可以在两周左右收到你的成绩。

问:在IELTS 测试中多少分才算及格?

在 IELTS 测试中是没有及格与不及格的概念的。你想进入的大学或学院会告诉你,你 所希望修读的课程所需要的 IELTS 分数。请注意,他们或许要求你在考试中某一个部分取 得制定的分数(通常在写作部分)。

问: IELTS 测试得分是如何计算的?

在四部分的测试中,最高分是 9 分,最低为 0 分(其中写作和口试部分是没有半分的)。你的总分是四个部分的分数的平均,百分位分值按四舍五人计算。

取平均分 (25/4 = 6.25), 然后百分位四舍五人, 总分是 6.5 分。 问:参加 IELTS 测试的时间间隔是多长? 如果你再次参加 IELTS 测试, 你必须要等至少 3 个月的时间。

2. 雅思口语考试概述

The Speaking Module takes between 11 and 14 minutes. It consists of an oral interview between the candidate and the examiner.

There are three main parts. Each part fulfils a specific function in terms of interaction pattern, task input and candidate output.

In Part 1, the candidate answers general questions about themselves, their homes, families, jobs, studies, interests, and a range of similar topic areas. This part lasts between four and five minutes.

In Part 2, the candidate is given a verbal prompt on a card and is asked to talk on a particular topic. The candidate has one or two minutes to prepare before speaking at length for exactly two minutes. The examiner will cut you off immediately after two minutes.

In Part 3, the examiner then asks some questions relevant to the topic previously talked about. The examiner and candidate will engage in a discussion of more abstract issues and concepts which are thematically linked to the topic prompt in part 2. The discussion lasts between four and five minutes.

All interviews are recorded on an audio cassette. The overall structure of the test is summarized below.

Part 1

Introduction and interview.

The examiner introduces himself or herself and confirms candidate's identity. Examiner interviews candidate using verbal questions selected from familiar topic frames.

4-5 minutes

Part 2

Individual long turn

Examiner asks candidate to speak for 1-2 minutes on a particular topic based on a written input in the form of general instruction and content – focused prompts on a card.

Examiner asks one or two questions to round off the long turn.

3 - 4 minutes including 1 or 2 minute's preparation time.

Part 3

Two - way discussion

Examiner invites the candidate to participate in discussion of more abstract nature, based on verbal questions thematically linked to part 2 topic.

4-5 minutes

The Speaking module assesses whether candidates can communicate effectively in English.

Detailed performance descriptors have been developed which describe spoken performance at the nine IELTS bands on four analytical subscales: Fluency and Coherence; Lexical Resource; Grammatical Range and Accuracy; and Pronunciation. Scores are reported as whole bands only.

The examiner is a qualified teacher or certificated examiner appointed by the test center and approved by the British Council or IELTS Australia.

雅思口语考试是 10-15 分钟考生与主考官的一对一谈话,对谈大致上分三部分,三部分中间没有间断,没有明显的区分。

第一部分:会面,寒暄,谈论几个一般话题(姓名、家乡、爱好、学习生活、工作等),约3-4分钟。

第二部分: 主考官拿出一张 (Cue Card), 卡上写明一个话题和需要谈论的内容, 考生准备 1-2 分钟, 之后对此话题连续谈论 1-2 分钟, 考官不会中途打断。

第三部分:考官针对第二部分的话题问几个广泛而深入的问题,要考生回答。此部分约4-5分钟。

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3. 多做练习

与外教或口语较好的人练习针对雅思口语考试常考的题目,并请他们指出你的错误和 不足。自己也可以和自己做练习,有时可以用录音机将自己的回答录下来,自己检查。

四、雅思口语考试技巧

1. 做好准备和轻松面对

您必须做好准备和提前到场。记得带您的证件(身份证或护照等)以证明您的身份, 还要记得带准考证。

测验开始时会录音。您不用担心,录音只是用来确保面试官没有做错任何步骤。第一印象非常重要,您应尽量讲有意思和有趣的话题。发音也很重要,再有趣和有意思的话题都必须要让人容易听得懂。要记得英语的表达很着重语调和高低音。身体、语言也可以帮助表达,放松自己,但也不要显得太轻松。尽量让您的身体告诉面试官您不紧张和有自信。

2. 尽量主动和积极

回答问题时千万不要只答 "Yes"或 "No"。这个测验的目的是让您有机会说话,您要放开胆量说话。面试官的角色是负责引导您说话,在整个面试过程中您说话时间的比例至少要占 75% 至 80%,在回答问题时您要表现出正面的态度。考生通常都应该诚实地回答所有问题,但有一些问题,回答的时候还是应该保持比较正面。例如问您对英国的印象、就算您真的认为非常不好、也不应说出口。

3. 答案须清晰而详细

千万不要刻意用一些深奥或复杂的字来解释事情。不要以为这样可以加深面试官的印象,一个简洁易明的答案绝对比一个复杂难明的答案好。简单的答案不代表短答案,短答

4. 应做的事

- 1) 保持微笑和眼神接触;
- 2) 当和面试官握手的时候,用力一点以表诚意;
- 3) 清晰和详细地回答:
- 4) 大方地谈及自己的事情和经验以控制场面;
- 5) 测验前多练习,以肯定您能准确运用过去式等语法;
- 6) 不需面试官太多提示而流利地讲出个人见解:
- 7) 能流利解释、描述或说明一件事情的发生;
- 8) 表现出您愿意讨论这个题目,就算您对它不熟悉,您也可围绕着这个题目发挥;
- 9) 在正式开始讲解前,先说明您会提到的要点;
- 10) 对不认识的题目, 您可尝试猜测。用 "maybe"、"perhaps" 等字会比什么也不说好:
- 11) 对深奥的问题,您可尝试推测,尽量用简单的英语表达深奥的意思,不要随便放弃作答;
 - 12) 继续保持轻松态度直至离开面试室;
 - 13) 有力地、有信心地握手并向面试官道谢;
 - 14) 请记住,最后印象和第一印象同样重要。

5. 不应做的事

- 1) 不要告诉面试官您很紧张,也不要眨眼太多和眼珠有太多移动;
- 2) 握手时不要让面试官以为自己在握着一条死鱼;
- 3) 不要让对话在短句上中止;
- 4) 当面试官期望您进一步说明时,不要随便停下;
- 5) 有语法错误时不要害怕,应镇定地更正,但在口语考试中,流利度绝对比语法准确度重要;
 - 6) 不要说您不懂这个题目或您从来未想过这些事情;
 - 7) 当您听不明白问题时,不用担心,您可要求面试官重复一次;
 - 8) 不要离题, 否则面试官会以为您听不明白题目;
 - 9) 不要等面试官问问题,要表现出您有能力讨论题目而不需任何提示帮助;
- 10) 不要回答得太简单,例如,被问及您的工作时,千万不要只回答"我在一家公司里工作"。您可说出公司名称,您可说出您的职位和职责;
- 11) 千万不要在测验完成后对面试官说您有多高兴考试已完成,您也不应在面试官面前评论自己的表现;
 - 12) 不要问考试官您的成绩,他(她)是一定不会说的;
 - 13) 不要表现过分热情, 您只需保持微笑地离开便可。

6. 对深奥的问题, 您可尝试推测, 不要随便放弃作答, 可使用的用语
