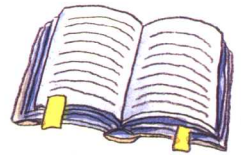
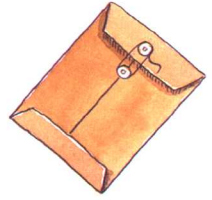


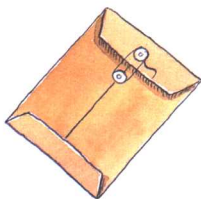
















Tuesday was a big day for Amy. It was a big day for everyone, but for Amy, it was a very big day.

“Watch this,” said Jason.

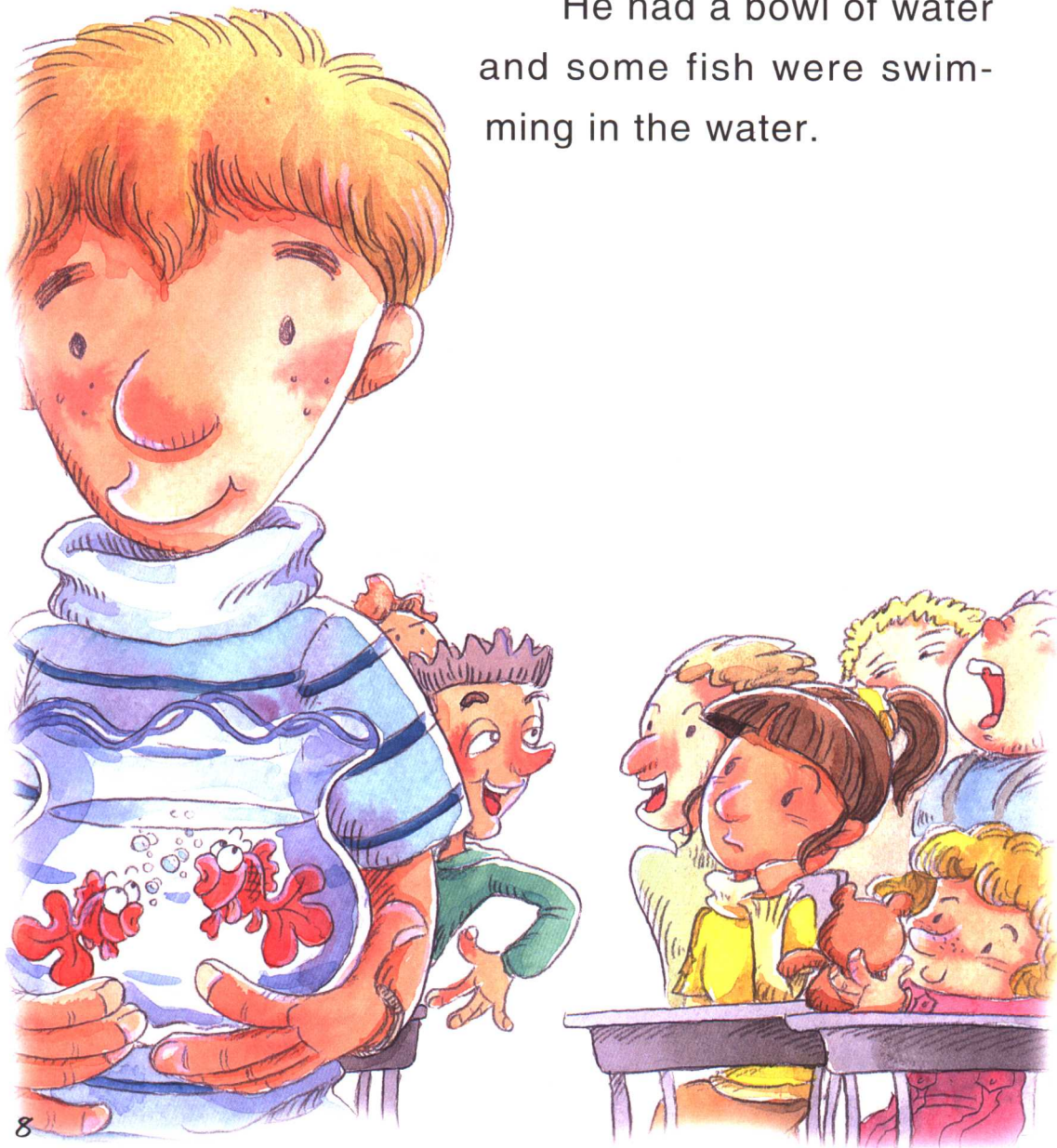
He put his shoes on and started jumping up and down.

“Can you hear it? ” he asked eagerly.

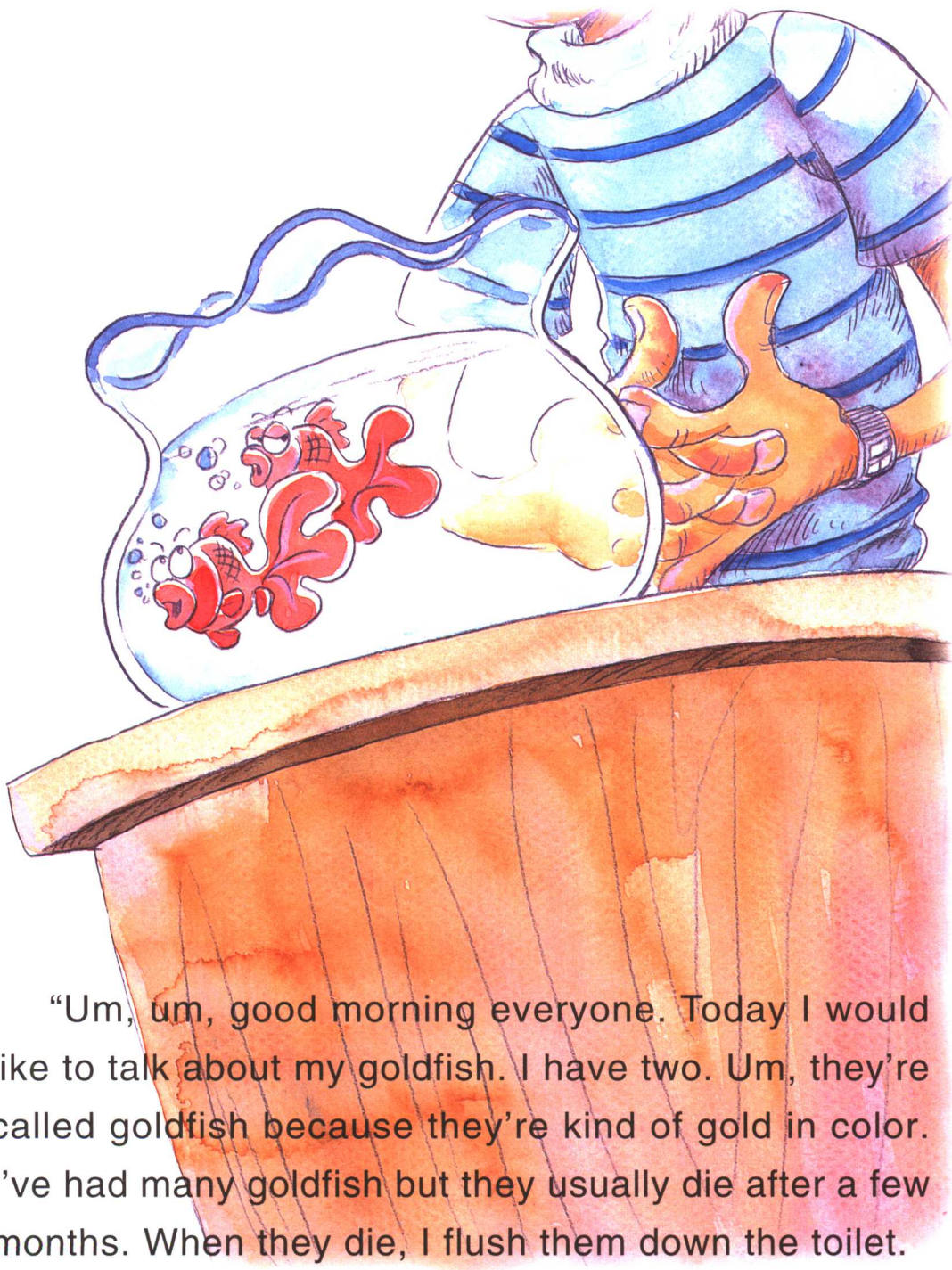
