Preface

记得有一位从事外语教学和管理工作的朋友说过:在引进的原版外语教材中,《走遍美国》是策划得最为成功的一种。"策划"这个字眼,似乎总是与商业炒作密切相关。然而如果仅仅是炒作,如果《走遍美国》这套教材本身并不具备价值和生命力,那么它的成功就会充其量不过是昙花一现而已。在我们看来,《走遍美国》之所以能够长时间获得我国英语学习者的认可和喜爱,除了其他许多原因之外,最重要的还是因为它在目前市场上流行的众多英语教材中具有不可或缺的特质。

《走遍美国》最突出的特色可以用多用途、口语化和实用性来加以概括。有不少学习者将《走 遍美国》视为中级英语读本,这似乎不无道理,但又失之偏颇。虽然《走遍美国》不宜用作"零起 点"英语教材,但稍通英语者便可以感觉到它的课文和练习平易近人,鲜有晦涩难懂之处,尤其 是新世纪版《走遍美国》中的译文、注解、各种练习、文化点滴以及配套影碟等等,极大地方便了 刚刚起步的英语自学者;同样,多年学习乃至精通英语者也能从《走遍美国》中找到自己所迫切 需要的东西,那就是我们在一般教材中难得接触到的地道、实用、与多种多样交际环境十分相宜 的英语口语表达法,以及一些在日常生活当中经常使用的书面用语。凡是曾经出过国或与外国 友人交流较多的英语学习者通常都会有一种共同的感觉:我们在国内所学习的英语教材或读本 大多具有浓重的书面语色彩,语体过于拘谨,风格过于庄重,文法过于谨严;更有甚者,某些英语 读物其实已或多或少趋于"语法化"甚至"汉化",与语言交流的实际环境不大吻合。在我国,即便 许多英语专业教师说起英语来也常常拘泥于形式、规则和表面词义,显得生硬、机械、呆板,理性 有余,原汁原味不足。而《走遍美国》中的英语语言直接来源于逼真的美国语境,它具有浓厚的生 活气息,适用于各种不同的交际情景和场合,令学习者仿佛有一种身临其境的感觉;它是新鲜活 泼的,既可达意,亦能传情,又趣味盎然;同时,它又是无拘无束和自由奔放的,它以符合约定俗 成的习惯为标准(而非仅仅符合语法),以不事准备、不假思索的流利性和随意性为特征;它正好 可以帮助我们克服对于英语语言的神秘感和畏惧感,有利于我们在轻松和休闲的心态中体味多 种风格的英语语言。

也正是由于《走遍美国》的这一特色,我们在编写《走遍美国参考书》时将多用途、口语化和实用性视为一定要尽力遵守的圭臬,尽管我们深知以我们现有的功力未必能进入如此美妙的境界。所谓"多用途",即无论教材中的练习多么简单,一般都提供答案,供初学者参考,以期有助于他们无师自通;同时,某些练习的答案实际上已经超越了中级英语范围,达到了高级英语水准,既是为了满足那些水平较高的自学者,使之不至于感到无所收获,也是为了让初学者有跳跃式进步和发展的空间。所谓"口语化",指的是我们所提供的答案,特别是对话类和短文类答案,将尽可能地模仿原教材的口语化特征,或尽量使用流畅、地道的表达法、短语和词汇,努力做到符合英语语言的表达习惯,而不是简简单单地按照英语语法去编写表面"正确"的句子。习外语者必须清醒地认识到,"正确"并非是最高标准,"精确"(即贴切和地道)才是我们永远追求的目标。

至于"实用性",至少具有两个方面的含义:一是更多地提供一些日常交流中实用的表达法;二是在任何可能的情况下将学习者的注意力重新引向原教材所提供的实用的短语、片语和实用文体。

需要说明的是:本书所提供的练习答案只是参考答案,不仅有许多造句类、短文类、编写履历类和剧情描述类练习可以有不同的答案,学习者完全可以根据自己的特殊情况、习惯、爱好和语言水平等等加以发挥,即便是某些所谓客观选择题,如课文理解、影像和图画的诠释以及人物言行的解释等等,也可以在参考本书答案的基础上提出不同见解,甚至以本书答案为假想敌,展开讨论,因为有少量客观题的确具有一定开放性和模糊性,从不同角度切入可以得出不同但却合理的答案。作为本书的编写者,我们所希望于学习者的,是用英语来进行这种口头的或书面的讨论。无论是《走遍美国》这套教材,还是这本参考书,都不是以应付某种英语考试作为自己的目的,所以它的重心是放在为广大的英语爱好者开拓更为广阔和自由的学习空间之上,力争建立更为灵活的英语语言训练机制。

当然,我们自知能力和水平有限,在改编教材的过程中,特别是在本书答案的过程中,难免在一些语言细节上,在对多用途、口语化和实用性等目标的追求方面,出现舛误与疏漏。我们真诚地欢迎各种批评和建议,以便在今后能够让这套教材和这本参考书的质量更上一层楼。

参加本书编写工作的同志有龙江、王爱菊、熊伟、李杜、任晓晋。另外,在戴丹妮老师的协助下,武汉大学英文系有程骊妮、招敏仪、吴蔚、王晶、曹纹婧、吴慕枫、韩隽、徐萍、杨柳、徐琴超、王云、陈丹、李雯等多位同学参与了词汇表的整理和注释工作,为本书的尽快完成做出了贡献。在此,我谨代表本书编者向他们表示谢意。


