书中加入了笔者在跨考教育的教学实践中对考研英语的一些独到的见解和体会,对考生很有启发性,可用于考生在考研复习的基础阶段的自学,也可用作基本的知识手册用于考研后期的复习巩固。

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前 言

本书旨在帮助考生循序渐进的掌握考研英语单词,从而攻克考研道路上的最大难关。本书分为四个梯度,基础词汇、进阶词汇、高阶词汇、真题词汇,从易到难,循序渐进。本书打破了现在很多词汇书籍主次不清、难易不分、平均分配时间和精力的编排方式,从而给考生更明确的指导。

本书采用练习与记忆结合的方式学习单词,每个单词列出其记忆的方法、派生词、例句等帮助记忆。例如:
