前 言

本书的主要目的是帮助考生在考前系统地复习并且熟悉、掌握英语应用能力考试的重点、范围和形式。本书编写的主要依据是:1)高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求及高等学校英语应用能力考试大纲;2)历年试卷的重点和难点;3)考生容易答错的难点;4)高职高专学生英语的弱点和常犯错误。编者力求本书符合高职高专学生的实际需求,具有针对性和实用性,帮助他们打好英语基础,提高英语水平。

本书由语法分项练习、词汇变形练习及模拟试题等几大部分组成,此外还附有两份最近考试的真题供同学们参考。“语法分项练习”包括时态和语态、非谓语动词、主从复合句、介词、虚拟语气、倒装结构、一致关系、限定词八大项目,基本上覆盖了英语应用能力考试的语法重点和题型。“词汇变形练习”是英语能力考试难度较大的项目。编者从大纲词汇表中筛选出能够派生出名词、动词和形容词的重点词汇的变形练习 200 多题。掌握这些词的变形基本上就可以从容地面对这种形式的考题。

“模拟试题”完全按照考试大纲中样题的形式和要求,经过仔细推敲和筛选编写而成。要提高英语能力,一定要多做练习,“熟能生巧”就是这个道理。
