Man cannot discover new oceans unless he has courage to lose sight of the shore.

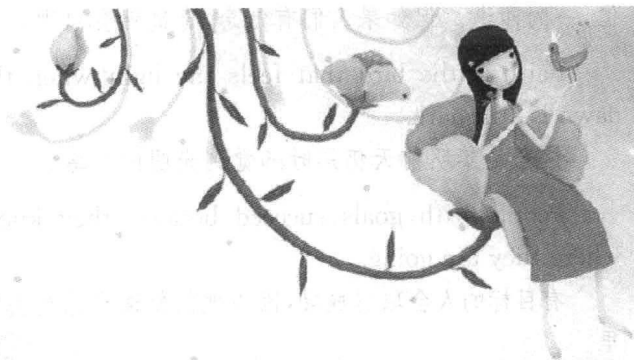
没有勇气航行到看不见海岸的地方,就不可能发现新天地。
