- lectures from a course of study Section 4

Common Listening Topics

You will hear topics which are often used in the IELTS listening test. For example:

- social needs such as asking for directions, prices or information (Sections 1 and 2)
- education topics such as courses of study, or common academic topics (Sections 3 and 4)

Vocabulary

Each unit contains exercises to help you to recognise and learn useful vocabulary for the listening texts. There are lists of useful phrases which are common in the IELTS listening test. You will practice:
