前　　言

中国人学英语，首先遇到的就是发音困难，英语法除了很多语音音素与汉语语音音素不一致以外，还有一些音素是汉语所没有的，如舌根音[ŋ]、舌齿音[θ]和[ð]，乃至唇齿音[f]和[v]等。这都要求我们学习读和说英语的时候，开发口腔中新的发音部位，而这样的开发需要大量的训练。但是，语言学习是为表达思想感情的，无语言意义的机械训练很容易使人感到乏味。为此，人们集外语学习之大成，编出了有意义、有趣味的绕口令，以帮助外语学习者专心、有效地练习语音语调。英语绕口令就是这样产生，并一直在人们的英语学习中发挥着独特作用的。

本书所编的英语绕口令一是编者前不久在国外学习期间广泛收集而成的，二是自己在国内多年的英语教学中有心点滴积累的部分。现将它们按主要发音音素归类，编著成册，奉献给广大英语学习者和爱好者，希望对你们有帮助，并祝你们成功！


