## 原书前言

《Maingot 腹部手术学》始终充满了独特的优势。对于包括本书编者在内的许多外科医生而言,本书一直能够提供重点在于腹部外科疾病的手术策略和技术的全面讨论。本书已经成为我们在常规手术前或新手术准备过程中更新知识的一本必需参考书。本版的目标读者与以往版本一样,仍然是外科训练者以及执业医师。有机会编写这本经典教科书的第11版是一种殊荣。

自1940年 Rodney Maingot 編写第 1 版以来,腹部手术已经发生了明显变化。不仅我们的知识基础大幅度增加,而且手术操作本身也已经变得更加复杂。作为这些变化结果的现代腹部外科的亚专业,甚至可能质疑这种内容全面的教材的必要性。目前腹部疾病正在越来越多地被前肠、肝胆、胰腺、结直肠、内分泌、血管和微创外科等专业医师瓜分。在本版中我们已经认识到专业化问题,因此选择去除了有关腹部外伤和血管疾病的章节,取而代之的重点在于胃肠道的疾病。然而,对于消化系统疾病而言,我们仍然坚信每一个解剖区域病变的外科处理基本原则的共同点多于分歧。在上述任一器官上获得的经验可以为另外任一器官的处理提供信息、加深了解。很少有人怀疑腹部外科医生必须具备熟练处理既定手术操作过程中遇到的任何突发性疾病的能力的需要。对于我们许多人来说,《Maingot 腹部手术学》一如既往地满足了这种需要。除了依照其器官/操作的编写格式之外,我们也打算保持这本教科书以疾病为重点的特点。

新版的教科书是经过彻底修订的一本全新的教科书。我们试图将本书的重点 放在手术操作步骤上,同时包括新的腹部疾病诊断和处理观念。为了与许多其他临 床教科书的趋势符合,我们显著缩短了本版本的长度。虽然文字更为简明,但是我 们仍然表达了大量专家的观点和见解。我们继续保持了原书的国际风味,而且在胃 肠外科章节既有经验丰富的资深撰稿人,也有新的领导者。

本版进行了广泛的艺术创作,再现了许多线条图用于反映撰写者完成某些外科手术的首选方法,其中的一些图是全新的,使本书的外观更现代、整体一致性更强。

Rodney Maingot 在第 6 版的前言中指出,"由于所有作品是个人的,所有撰写者在其个人章节上已被赋予了自由。行文风格和文字表达方面的特定范围将会激起读者的深思熟虑。"我们同样试图为读者保持一致,同时作者在其个人章节撰写

上也获得了足够的自由。

我们衷心地感谢上一版的主编,Seymour Schwartz 医师,感谢他对本版准备工作的协助。没有他的支持和指导,我们将无法出版这本书。
