A

A country's latitude (纬度), or distance from the equator, has an important effect on its climate. In places located at low latitudes, or near the equator, like Ecuador (厄瓜多尔) and northern Brazil (巴西), the amount of sunshine changes the least during the year. At mid-latitudes, in places like Japan or Argentina (阿根廷), there is more sunshine in the summer than in the winter. The greatest change occurs at the highest latitudes, in places like northern Canada or Alaska. In these places, the nights are very long for half the year, and the days are long during the other half. At the North or South Pole, sunlight lasts the longest during the summer.
