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
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编写与使用说明

《新世纪实用英语综合练习 I 》是与《新世纪实用英语综合教程 I 》同步编写的系列配套用书。本书包括了《新世纪实用英语综合教程 I 》每个单元应该掌握的语言知识、语法知识、翻译知识和阅读知识。其宗旨是为了使学生进一步巩固和拓展他们的英语语言基本知识及技能,培养学生自觉学习的意识及能力。

本书共有八个单元,供第一学期使用。每个单元主题都延续了教材的单元主题。每个单元的练习都是从高职高专学生的实际英语水平出发,形式多样,循序渐进,并紧密结合高等学校英语应用能力考试的特点和题型来设计。每单元分四个部分:

- 1. 词汇操练:本部分的五道练习题紧密结合课文中的重点词汇、语言难点和重点、基本和常用句型,多角度、全方位进行练习和应用。形式多样,由浅入深地扩大学生的词汇量,使其能够牢牢掌握每个单元的语言知识点。
- 2. 语法巩固:本部分共有两道练习题,通过全面、系统、实用、有效的练习形式,帮助学生进一步牢固掌握英语基本语法。
- 3. 阅读理解:本部分共有三篇文章,通过对主题相关的更深层次文章的阅读,培养学生快速阅读和分析问题、解决问题的能力,逐步引导他们在阅读过程中做到阅读与思维同步,帮助和指导他们从现有的材料中获取信息,训练他们分析判断、归纳总结、熟练应用所学语言知识的技能和技巧。
- 4. 翻译实践:本部分完全采用英语应用能力考试的题型,让学生尽快熟悉考试题型, 掌握做题方法,并通过此项练习,帮助学生掌握一定的翻译知识和技巧。

本书内容丰富,并和教材内容相呼应、配套,可以供课堂教学使用,也可以供学生课外自学。各院校可以根据实际教学时数,选择使用每个单元中的相关内容,也可作为学生课后练习、自测、提高之用。

本书由苏丽英、周梅芝任主编,农时华、刘萍、黄忠电、徐旭娟、文燕任副主编,吴文亮、覃庆芳参与了编写。具体编写分工如下,第一单元由苏丽英、农时华、吴文亮编写,第二单元由徐旭娟编写,第三单元由黄忠电编写,第四单元由文燕编写,第五单元由覃庆芳编写,第六单元由苏丽英、农时华编写,第七单元由周梅芝编写,第八单元由刘萍编写。
