Stephen Hawking was born in 1942 in Oxford, England. When he was twenty-

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one, he got a terrible disease that nearly killed him. But he didn't give up his life to the disease and lived on to get married and become a famous scientist later. Stephen has spent his life studying and thinking about the origins (起源) of the universe and how it can be explained by using the modern theories of physics.

Glass is easy to recycle. Glass bottles must not be mixed with other types of glass such as dishes or light bulbs, which are not good for recycling. Clear glass is most valuable (有价值的). Mixed color glass has almost no value. It is necessary to remove the lids (盖子) for recycling.

Paper
