#### 前言

为了帮助具有一定英语水平的读者检测所学知识,在较短时间内巩固并提高运用英语的能力和应试能力,我们编写了这本"英语疑难精解1000"。

全书分为十五个单元,按英语语法体系编排,全部采用选择填空形式;设计的题目,内容丰富,且具有一定的难度和典型性。为了检测读者的口语能力,最后一单元设计了各种场合下的情景对话练习。每单元后面均有答案,并对某些语言重点和难点进行解释和归纳总结。提示富有启发性、概括性,使读者看后能触类旁通,举一反三。

江西师范大学外语系副教授俞百岚先生在百忙中审阅了此 书,在此表示衷心感谢。

由于我们水平有限, 教学工作繁重, 不当和错误之处在所难免, 敬请广大读者批评指正。

学好英语并非易事,除要大量阅读外,还应仔细推敲其中词语的正确用法,这样不仅可以都助记忆词语,而且用起来也可以得心应手。人们学习一种外语,开始总会受到母语的影响,往往不自觉地把母语中某些习惯用法迁移到所学的另一种语言中去,要是不认真去辨别两种语言的异同,错误就会因此而产生。儿童学习语言主要靠模仿,而成年人由于逻辑思维能力不断增长,学习外语主要靠理解,即在理解的基础上学习外语。

《英语疑难精解 1000》参照成年人学习外语的心理特点,有心理学的理论根据,因而具有科学性;例句解释简明扼要,叙述了哪一个答案是正确的理由,因而具有启发性;例句顺序安排按语法系统分类,条理清楚,因而具有系统性;例句针对我国学习者容易混淆或不易识别的语言难点,因而具有实用性。本书不仅对广大中学生学习和升学考试具有指导意义,而且对有志自学成材者和一般大学生也具有一定的参考价值。

salary 指机关单位官员、职工和管理人员的"薪金",一般按年计算,分月、半月发给。

wage 一般指工人或服务人员等体力劳动者的"工资"、"工钱",通常按时计算,分周发给。一般用复数形式,但不能被 many, few 修饰,只能被 high, low 等词修饰。如: His wages are high (low)。
