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前 言

我国的社会主义现代化建设不但需要高级科学技术专家,而且迫切需要中、初级技术人员、管理人员和技术工人。而这类人才的培养主要是通过职业技术教育来实现的。所以党和国家非常重视职业技术教育的改革和发展。努力培养出各行各业所需的职业人才,是社会、经济发展对职业技术教育提出的迫切要求。我国的职业技术教育长期实行的是“学科本位”的教学模式,这种模式重理论轻实践,重知识轻技能,培养出的学生不适应社会、经济发展的要求。因此,职业技术教育要深化改革,办出特色,为社会培养出既有理论又有技能、德、智、体全面发展的一代新人。

职业技术教育要办出自己的特色,关键在于课程改革与教材建设。为此,1996年上海市教委启动了职业技术教育课程改革与教材建设工程,简称“10181”工程,即用五年左右的时间,完成10门普通文化课程的改革及示范教材的编写工作;完成18个典型专业(工种)的课程改革以及同步编写出部分典型示范性教材;经过十年左右的改革实践,基本形成一个具有职教特色的课程结构和教材体系。

我们这次课程改革与教材建设是以社会 and 经济发展需要为出发点,以职业(岗位)需求为直接依据,以现行中等职业技术教育课程、教材的弊端为突破口,积极学习并借鉴国外职教课程、教材改革的有益经验,以实现办出职教特色的根本目的。在充分研究和广泛征求意见的基础上,确立了“能力为本位”的改革指导思想。目的是为了克服职教长期存在的重理论轻实践、重知识轻技能的倾向,真正培养出经济和社会发展所需要的中等职业技术人才。

在各方面的共同努力下,新的教材终于与广大师生见面了。这些新的教材并不是职业技术教育课程改革与教材建设的全部,它只是典型的示范性教材,因为职业技术教育的专业门类繁多,不可能在较短的时间内,依靠少数编写人员解决职教中全部的课程、教材问题。职教的课程改革和教材建设是一项系统的长期的工作,只有充分发挥广大教师的改革积极性,在教学过程中不断用“能力为本位”的教育思想,主动进行课程与教材的改革,我们的课程、教材改革才能全面、持续而深入,才可能真正全面提高教学质量和效益,以不断适应社会、经济发展的需要。因此,“10181”工程对于我市的职教课程改革来讲只起着一个领导、指导和引导的作用。

新的教材代表新的思想、新的教法和学法。希望通过这些教材,给大家一些启迪,同时也希望大家对新教材提出宝贵的意见。

在课程改革与教材建设过程中,得到了各方面的大力支持,特别是广大编审人员为此付出了辛勤的劳动。在此,向他们表示衷心的感谢!
