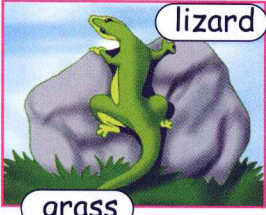
The nightingale sang a beautiful song

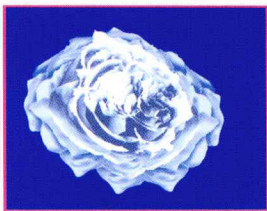
