

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前言

然而，尽管我们在小学、初中或多或少学过点英语，一旦遇到老外却仍然张口结舌，似乎开口说英语是一件很难的事，其实不然，假如您能熟练掌握本书所教授的 150 个高频句型及相关的单词和词组，您就可以对日常生活中的衣、食、住、行、玩用英语表达。

为了帮助您迅速且有效地掌握实用生活英语，本书着眼于“生活需求”，提炼衣、食、住、行、玩的常用单词和句子，以“模拟—实践”的语言操练形式进行编写。

本书有三大特色：

(1) 本书呈现的单词和句型，都是就某一主题进行交流时最常用的，能让学生在最短的时间内学到最具实用性的句子。

(2) 高频句型 (Frequently-used Sentences) 以不同形式重复出现，重点突出；为学生提供模拟练习场景，易学易懂；图文并茂，有助于提高学生的学习兴趣。这些设计能够使学生快速有效地掌握学习的内容。

(3) 每章的结对练习 (Pairwork) 部分添加了与本主题相关的其它单词和词组，有助于学生在练习时扩充自己的词汇量，充分表达自己的想法。

编者认为只要您熟读本书，熟记书中跟衣、食、住、行、玩有关的单词和词组，灵活运用本书列出的高频句型，多找些机会大胆地跟朋友、同学用英语聊聊，久而久之，熟能生巧，说英语便会成为一件轻松、愉快的事。


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
