



M: What kind of animals do these bones belong to?

W: Well, there was the great lion, and hundreds of saber-toothed 剑齿的』tigers, both of which became extinct 灭绝的;绝种的』when the other animals disappeared ... oh, and giant sloths 树懒』which hung upside down in the trees. Then they found the skulls 「颜骨;脑壳」 of giant buffaloes 「野牛』, and horses much like the ones we have today, but they are all extinct now, of course.

- 12. John doesn't think they've left the office yet.
 - = He thinks they're still at the office.
- 13. No sooner had I started to type my paper than the telephone rang. [从小学到老的句型]
 - = Someone called just as I started to work.【王牌精品句】
 - 【注】这个句型在学校英语课上反复讲解,大多数人都是 "认识"的,但能脱口而出的就没有几个了。
 - * He had no sooner reached/No sooner had he reached his house than it began to rain.

 (他一到家就开始下雨了。)
- The fire was prevented from spreading because of Stone's quick action.
 - = Stone stopped the fire from spreading.

 - = I was feeling sleepy and so I took a walk.

- = The college faculty chose the committee members.
