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Preface

The 1984-85 *Yearbook of Higher Education: A Directory of Colleges and Universities* provides comprehensive coverage of the world of higher education through detailed listings for degree-granting institutions of postsecondary education in the United States and Canada. Included are descriptions of accredited two-year business, technical, and community colleges; four-year colleges and universities; and graduate and professional schools offering advanced degrees.

In the United States section, institutions listed are primarily those with member, candidate, or applicant accreditation status with the accrediting agencies that are recognized by the Council on Postsecondary Accreditation (COPA). These nongovernmental voluntary agencies establish criteria, evaluate institutions at their request, and extend their approval to those whose purposes, resources, and performance entitle them to the confidence of the educational community and the public. Institutions listed in *Higher Education* are empowered to grant degrees, AA being the minimum. Proprietary schools are included only if they have achieved junior college status with one of the accrediting agencies.

There is no formal system of accreditation of universities in Canada. Each institution holds a provincial charter which, in conjunction with membership in the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada, constitutes the closest equivalent to accreditation.

Higher Education lists institutions by country. Schools in the United States are subdivided by state or territory and Canadian schools by province. As with previous editions, order is alphabetical for individual institutions. In this year's edition, branch or affiliated campuses also appear in alphabetical order for easier reference; institutional affiliation is provided in the listing. Similarly, each main system or central administration office includes a cross-reference to all member institutions. Institutions that have closed or undergone a name change in the past year are included by the name of the institution, its location, and a statement either indicating closure or referring the user to the listing under the institution's new name.

Each complete entry provides the user with a composite picture of an institution by supplying address, telephone number, year founded, type or level of school, degree program(s) offered, affiliation or control, student body, calendar system, average full- and part-time enrollment, faculty figures, academic year opening and closing dates, year accredited and accrediting agencies, library holdings, average annual tuition, institutional affiliates, and average SAT or ACT scores of entering freshmen. A full listing of administrative personnel, academic deans, and department or division heads completes each entry.

This edition lists administrative personnel in hierarchical order by title and then groups academic deans and department or division heads alphabetically by discipline. Every attempt has been made to follow institutional preference in administrative and disciplinary titles. All listings are in English, with the exception of a few Canadian schools where titles for personnel appear in French, as requested by the participating institution.

Schools for which no updated data were received are included, either as they appeared in the last edition or revised where possible through staff research. These entries are designated for the user by an asterisk following the name of the institution, two asterisks if more than one edition has elapsed since receiving updated data.

We wish to thank the many people in the academic community for supplying us with updated data each year. Without their generous cooperation, this volume would not be possible.

An alphabetical index to institutions completes *Higher Education*. The index lists institutions, supplying name and state, as well as closure or name change information if pertinent. References are to item numbers.

How to Use This Directory

The *Yearbook of Higher Education: A Directory of Colleges and Universities* lists 3,623 institutions alphabetically by state or province. Listings are arranged in alphabetical order according to the first letter of the full name of the institution. A complete alphabetical index is provided at the end of the directory for easy access.

Information for each listing is arranged as follows:

Name, Address, and Telephone Number: Complete name of the institution, street address, and main telephone number; where appropriate, the mailing address and/or branch campus addresses are also given.

Member Institutions: A cross-reference to all member institutions of a main system or central administration, if applicable.

Founded: The institution's founding date.

Type: The type or level of the institution, including two-year, four-year, graduate, and professional levels.

Degree Programs: The level(s) at which the institution offers degree programs. The following abbreviations are used: A, associate's degree; B, bachelor's degree; M, master's degree; D, doctoral degree; P, first professional degree.

Control: Brief description of public or private control, with church affiliation as appropriate.

Student Body: The type of student body (coed, men, women).

Calendar System: Semester, trimester, quarter, or other academic calendar.

Enrollment: Full-time and part-time enrollment figures for the current academic year.

Faculty: Number of full-time and part-time teaching faculty members.

Opening/Closing: 1984-85 academic year opening and closing dates; 1985 summer session opening and closing dates.

Institutional Affiliates: Institutions with which school is affiliated, shares faculty, and/or facilities; main system or central administration of which school is a member, if applicable.

Accreditation: Current or candidate status; name of accrediting agency(ies); year accreditation/candidacy was granted and most recent reaffirmation. (A Key to Accrediting Agency Acronyms directly follows this section.)

Library Facilities: Number of books, current periodical subscriptions, microform volumes, and other library holdings.

Average SAT or ACT Scores: Average scores of entering freshmen in the most recent year.

Average Annual Tuition: Average figures for annual tuition and/or fees, excluding room and board, for in-state and out-of-state students, undergraduate and graduate students, as appropriate.

Administrative Personnel: Key administrative officials in hierarchical order by title.

Academic Deans: Key academic deans or program directors in alphabetical order by title.

Academic Department Heads: Academic department or division heads in alphabetical order by department.
