前　　言

在现代科技中,博士论文的价值远远超越了获取学位本身,它涉及自然科学、社会科学各个领域,代表着每一学术领域的最高水准,展示新学科、新技术的诞生过程,追踪世界高科技的发展动态,提供大量翔实、准确的原始研究材料和数据,学术性与实用性兼备。利用者不仅可由此获取本专业最新研究动态与成果,还可据此学习研究方法,更新教材内容,建立专题文库。基于博士论文的特殊功效,我们根据北京图书馆的馆藏编撰这册《国外博士学位论文目录》,以使各界读者了解更多的国外博士论文信息。

北京图书馆是全国最大的国外博士论文收藏中心,现有美国、加拿大及欧洲400多所大学自1861年以来通过的博士论文15万件。本目录选取了1982——1992年的部分馆藏论文1万4千条,分社会科学、人文科学(共计3千条);自然科学、应用科学(共计1万1千条)两大部分,按学科分类,每一类目按题名字顺排列。每条目录内容包括:论文题名、作者、学位、大学、导师名称、获得学位时间、论文页数及该篇论文排序号(即北图索取号),其中1987年以前及以后的条目间用星号(****)分隔。1992年以后的论文将陆续报导。
