前 言

2013年8月,全国大学英语四、六级考试委员会颁布了大学英语四级考试(CET-4)样卷,本书参照该样卷内容、题型及考试要求设计而成,并在内容和题型上略有拓展,以增加练习形式的多样性和前瞻性。练习采用先分类后综合的编排方法,紧紧围绕大学英语课程教学要求,遵循外语学习基本规律,注重语言基础知识的掌握,突显基本应试技能的训练,以加强学生语言综合运用能力的培养。

但需提醒的是,语言练习仅仅是巩固外语学习和课堂正常教学内容的一种手段和方法,是外语学习和课堂教学的一个重要组成部分。学生应把主要精力集中在学好英语知识、练好英语基本功、掌握英语运用能力上。惟有这样,才能凭借自身的知识、能力和素质在考试中获得好成绩。本书编写的目的是有助于考生熟悉变化后的大学英语四级考试形式,有助于考生正确理解考试内容,有助于考生了解自己的薄弱环节,有助于考生掌握良好的学习方法和途径,切实提高学生英语学习的质量和效益。

全书共分四个练习部分和两个附录。第一部分为听力理解,分A、B、C三类。A类有50个短对话、20个长对话;B类有10篇短文理解;C类有10篇短文听写。第二部分为阅读理解,也分三类。A类为选词填空,共10篇短文;B类为信息配对,共10篇短文;C类为仔细阅读,共20篇短文,含篇章阅读理解、篇章词汇理解练习等。第三部分为综合技能训练,有10篇作文练习和10篇汉译英短文翻译。第四部分为4套模拟试题,涵盖了新版大学英语四级考试的全部要求和内容。套题根据正式试题答题顺序编排设计,共分四个部分:写作测试、听力理解、阅读理解、短文翻译。两个附录分别为听力理解的录音文字稿和所有练习的参考答案。

对于英籍教师 John 和 Ian 给予本书编写的帮助,以及上海外语教育出版社对本书的关心、支持和在付梓前的仔细编审和精心设计,我们在此一并致谢。

本书配有 MP3 录音下载。
