INTRODUCTION

The HOME AND SCHOOL READING GUIDE is a selected list of books for children at all reading levels. It is a source for books that will supplement the information contained in THE NEW BOOK OF KNOWLEDGE. It will also suggest books that answer the needs and interests of children. Every effort was made to include in this GUIDE recently published titles that reflect the trends, developments, and activities of today's rapidly changing world.

The READING GUIDE was not designed as a buying list for libraries. Its function is to direct young readers to titles that are fairly recent and readily available. Ideally, these suggestions will prompt the child to go to the school or public library, where many additional books will be available.

This GUIDE was organized as a separate unit to facilitate its frequent revision and to allow for a more extensive listing than is possible within the volumes of an encyclopedia. A separate reading guide also gives its user the opportunity to refer to all the related aspects of a subject without having to consult individual listings scattered through many volumes.

The attention of readers is called to book listings included in two articles in THE NEW BOOK OF KNOWLEDGE: "Book Awards for Children's Literature" (Vol. B, pp. 309-310b) and "Children's Literature" (Vol. C, pp. 245-248d).
