


The man says to the woman: "I can go to the big city and I can find work there. There's work in the city. I can't stay here. What can I do in the village?"

The man says to Carlos: "Be a good son, Carlos. Stay here and look after your mother. Look after your sisters, too. Pedro and I must go to the city."


Now he says to Pedro: "Put some clothes in a bag, and then go to bed. It's a long way to the city. We must get up early."

Now it is morning. The sun is coming up behind the mountains. Pedro and his father are leaving their home. Carlos is standing near his mother. She is crying.








Pedro and his father are walking to the big road. Pedro's father has a bag on his back. There are some clothes and a little food in it. Pedro is carrying a small bag.

Pedro's father can see the big road. He points at it and says: "Look, Pedro. Look down there. What can you see?"









Pedro answers: "I can see the big road. It's the road to the city. Look at the trucks on it." Pedro is pointing at the trucks.




The driver of the truck thinks: "This man and his son are tired. I have a big truck, so I can take them to the city."
