编写理念

1. 我们以学习英语的切身经验体味到:阅读和写作是英语水平提高到一定档次的最关键的两方面。提高阅读能力需要大量地阅读原版、地道的集知识性、趣味性为一体的英文文章,同时配合理解练习;提高写作能力,第一要看优秀作文,第二要写好文章看老师的评改意见,第三要模仿外国学生的优秀文笔,然后才能冲刺中考、高考的写作难关。
