INTRODUCTION

I call nobody's bluff when I say that the English language may be – indeed, *is* – a thing of beauty and a joy for ever for many of us, but it is also, particularly for those unfortunate beings trying to speak English when it does not come naturally to them, e.g., parrots, foreigners, Radio One disc-jockeys, fraught with problems and perils.

So bizarre and irrational is our English vocabulary that a knowledge of other languages, even Latin and Greek, is **not** much help in trying to find out the meaning of a great many English words, even to somebody like myself who speaks English fluently, well up to O-level standard. For instance, I wonder how many readers, however deeply British, knew the meanings of more than two or three of the following useful and everyday words (well, they were useful and everyday once)?

Bonze: The Portuguese word for a Japanese clergyman.

Vives: An equine disease of the submaxillary glands.

Muckluck: An Eskimo's boot.

Jettatura: The spell of the evil eye.

Zwanziger: An old Austrian silver coin.

Bearleap: A Tudor housewife's large shopping-basket.

Wapentake: An early administrative division of Yorkshire.

There are probably as many word fanciers like us as there are bird fanciers, yet we have no Royal Society for the Protection of Words, or Word Sanctuaries (affiliated to the Wildvowel Trust), and so lovely old words like those above fall by the wayside and drop out of the language. But, and it's a big but, we who love the language and enjoy messing about with it now have something immediately helpful, a guide to living English, a book, *Word File*, to nourish and sustain us in playing our little but obsessional word-games. Stuck for a 13-letter word, hyphenated, a tree, beginning TOO...? Page 286. There it is: TOOTHACHE-TREE. Win your Scrabble® game if there is such a thing as an 8-letter word beginning with Z? There is. Page 135, ZASTRUGA. Geographical.

You can look words up from whatever starting-point you wish – number of letters in word, subject-matter, alphabetical order...

So if you are reading this Preface in a bookshop, act fast. Take this book over to the till immediately, pay for it, and pop it proudly into your bearleap. It's all of a Yorkshire division to an Eskimo's boot that you'll never regret it.



HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

Word File is really very simple to use. In most word puzzling, both the number of letters and subject of the required word are known. For this reason, the book has been categorised systematically into main headings, most of which divide into several sub-sections. In each section all the relevant words are arranged alphabetically within lists of three to fifteen letters. So, you just check the particular subject you need in the Index, turn straight to the relevant page and zone in to the required word-length for the instant solution.

Notes

- (a) Whereas standard 's' plurals are not listed, common irregular plurals (eg, FUNGI) have been included.
- (b) Where any one word has two accepted spellings, both have been listed.
- (c) Where abbreviated forms of words such as SAINT occur (eg, ST BERNARD), they appear strictly alphabetically.
- (d) If you are looking for a particular kind of person, you must refer to PEOPLE, as they are not listed under any other heading (eg, FARMER is not in AGRICULTURE, but may be found under PEOPLE, sub-heading WORKERS).
- (e) If a word is not in one list where you think it should be, it may well appear in another more specialised list (eg, RIFLE is not to be found in MILITARY TERMS, but is in WEAPONRY).
- (f) Words have been duplicated in certain lists where there is an obvious overlap (eg, BAROMETER is in INSTRUMENTS & GAUGES as well as METEOROLOGY).
