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#### 本套丛书专为哪些人编写?

- ① 准备 TOEFL、IETLS、GRE、GMAT 等考试,但英语水平或词汇量不足,难以直接复习准备这些考试,需要一本实实在在,循序渐进提高词汇量及英文水平的人 —— 全套丛书从《Vocabulary Basic》始,逐一学习,直到《Vocabulary 23000》。

- ③ 准备参加大学英语六级考试的人 ——《Vocabulary Basic》 + 《Vocabulary 6000》,包括《英语教学大纲》规定的英语六级所应掌握的全部核心词汇。
- ④ 准备参加 TOEFL 考试、研究生入学考试的人 ——《Vocabulary Basic》+《Vocabulary 6000》+《Vocabulary 12000》, 包括TOEFL 考试、研究生入学考试所应掌握的全部核心词汇。
- ⑤ 所有以上读者均可首先学习或最后总结式学习《Vocabulary 23000》,采用英语拉丁、罗马、希腊词根、词缀记忆方法,为自己架好学习词汇之框架,轻松、快速扩大词汇量。
