已学过第一、二册的读者,对《跟我学》已有了很好的了解。第三册的内容在数量和难度 上又有增大,只要坚持学下去,进步将更加明显,最后的成果就可望也可及了。

对于从第三册刚开始加入学习的读者,我们再简要地介绍一些情况:

《跟我学》是八十年代的一套新型的基础英语外语教材。它是现代的多种手段的教学课本。多种手段包括电视节目、自学课本和供练习用的盒式录音带。《跟我学》利用多种媒介相互配合,为学好英语提供了多、快、好、省的途径。

《跟我学》中国版是根据英国原版改编的。中国版考虑到了中国学习英语的习惯和要求,提供了较多的文学材料。电视节目中的主要用语均编入了课文、例句和练习之中。电视节目中有些材料没有编入书本,是为了保留《跟我学》要求对听力的锻炼。

学习这套教材要用两年的时间。即使没有什么英语基础的人,也能学会英语的一般生活 用语,在与讲英语的外国人进行一般性交往时,不致在语言上还有大的障碍。

《跟我学》采用了交际教学法。这套教材的目的是教人学会听懂英语并会用英语与别人谈话,所以一开始就把重点放在日常会话及典型的交际情景方面。每一课的标题清楚地说明了这一课的重点。语法结构是作为掌握正确表达自己的语言能力的一种辅助手段。这种学习外语的方法就叫做"交际教学法"。

这个课程的整个内容是欧洲文化委员会规定的所谓"入门水平"所要求的基本语言。经过一年学习,达到预定水平的一半,这时叫做达到了"途中水平(Waystage)",也就是说你可以基本上用英语进行交往了。继续努力,学完四册书,就达到"入门水平(The Threshold Level)",也就是说在日常生活中用英语交往,在说英语的国家里独立生活也不会有语言上的大困难了。

我们在第一册和第二册的前言里谈到了一些学习方法,学第三册时仍应注意掌握好。我们想多说的一点是:贵在坚持。学习到第三册了,千万要坚持下去,切莫半途而废。努力跨出这一步,胜利就在望了。
