INTRODUCTION


This workbook is one of a series of six prepared for students of English as a second language. The six workbooks contain drill and review material covering all the basic patterns of English.

These workbooks have been designed to be used independently by students of English, but they can also be used as supplements to the six textbooks in the same series, or with any other series of textbooks.


DIRECTIONS


