### 前言

在大学英语四、六级考试中,经常会出现一些疑难试题。为了帮助广大同学更好地学好英语,攻克这些难点,笔者根据多年的教学经验,在研究了几年来四、六级试题的基础上,对所出现过的难点进行归纳、分类,编成了这本《大学英语四、六级疑难题集解》。

本书从 1993 年出版以来,深受广大读者青睐,是一本较为畅销的教辅书。修订版是笔者为配合四、六级新题型的特点,根据我国外语教学实际水平的要求,在初版的基础上做了大幅度的修订,增添了英、汉注解,便于读者自测、自学。
