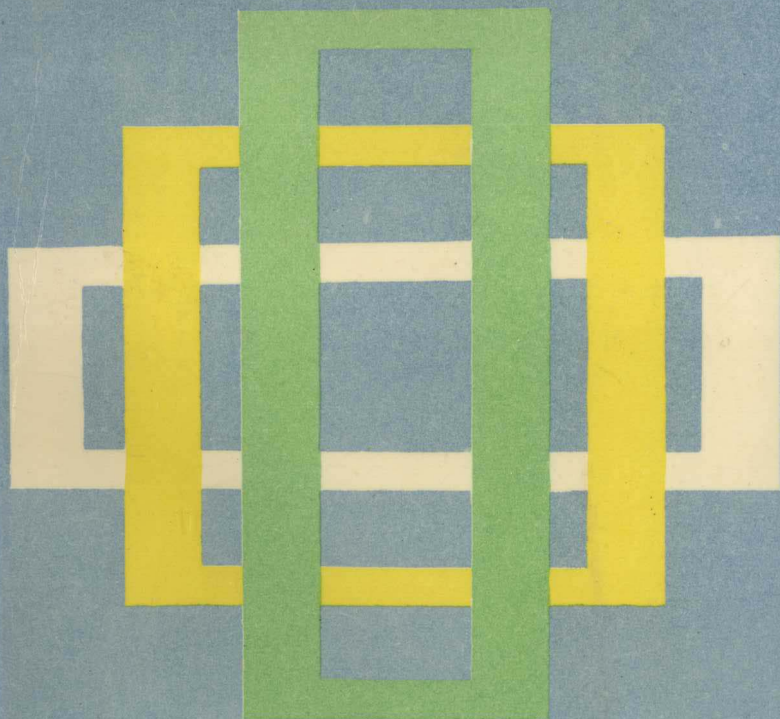

# 前 言

《大学英语应试听力》为《高级英语水平考试指导丛书》的第一分册,本分册根据《大学英语教学大纲》和大学英语四、六级《考试大纲》对听力所规定的要求编写,为参加大学英语四、六级考试的学生提供听力强化训练,以提高其听力理解能力及听力应试能力。

本书共分两大部分:第一部分为功能训练(Functional Drills);第二部分为模拟试题(Tests)。功能训练共两个单元:第一单元根据大学英语四、六级考试中听力试题的对话部分,按十个功能进行分项训练;第二单元根据大学英语四、六级考试中听力试题的短文部分的听力特点,分题材进行训练。第二部分则模拟大学英语四、六级真题,按难度循序渐进地进行有针对性的强化操练。

本书可作为大学英语听力课程的补充教材,通过本书有系统的强化训练,学生可望在听力理解和听力应试能力方面有较大的提高。

用作课堂教材时,第一部分的功能训练可以与第二部分的模拟试题结合交叉使用,以及时将功能技巧运用于解题实践。
