


"I need a new house," said

So Hedgehog went to look for a new house.


"I like your house, Otter," said Hedgehog. "But it is much too wet."




Hedgehog went to Rabbit's house.



"I like your house, Rabbit," said Hedgehog. "But there is no room for me."










Then Hedgehog went to Squirrel's house.
