前 言

《大学英语四级听力强化训练》旨在帮助大学英语学习者在参加大学英语四级考试之前相对集中地强化听力训练,为顺利通过考试做好充分的准备。

本书练习的编排分为三大部分:第一部分为对话操练(Drill),第二部分为听力试题(Listening Tests),第三部分为四级模拟试题(College English Model Tests)。对话操练部分的最大特点是按功能(如时间,地点,条件,否定,隐含意义等)分类编写,以突出重点,反复练习,给学习者留下较为深刻的印象,并使他们悟出其中的规律。听力试题的内容则尽量模仿国家大学英语四级考试听力部分样题。为了帮助英语学习者全面了解四级考试的具体测试项目,得到更多的机会身临其境进行实战训练,编者在认真分析四级考试样题的基础上严格参照《大学英语四级考试大纲》,编写了三套四级模拟试题。本书的练习均采用选择题的形式,目的是与四级考试同步。书中一部分试题选编自近期国内外出版的试题集,恕不一一注明出处。为了便于自学,书后附有听力原文材料和模拟试题的参考答案。

本书具有较强的针对性,比较概括和实用。使用本书进行系统的听力训练,会使广大四级英语应试者受益非浅,收到事半功倍的效果。-

本书不仅适用于高等院校的各科学生,也可作为准备参加托福、EPT等多类英语水平测试的人员、出国预备人员和英语爱好者的听力训练材料。
