



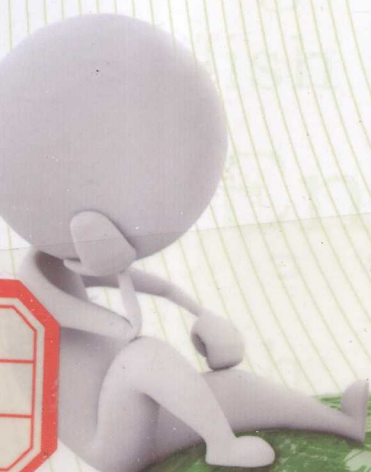

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前言 PREFACE

英语是世界上使用最为广泛的国际性语言之一,是学习科学文化知识,开展国际科学技术交流与合作的一个重要的语言工具,是为培养 21 世纪的具有高素质的职业技术人才服务的。本课程是高职高专各专业一门重要的、必修的公共基础课。本课程分为一、二级。通过本课程的学习,学生在完成第二级学习时应该达到《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》(试行)的 B 级目标。越来越多的学生希望能尽早了解和熟悉 B 级考试的具体题型,详细内容和难易程度,并为顺利通过考试做好准备,由此我们编写了《新编大学英语应试通关宝典(B 级应试指导)》。本书材料新,内容全,从解题思路、方法指导,到针对实考项目设置了专项强化训练,以便帮助学生更好地熟悉和掌握 B 级考试的具体题型以及解题方法。

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第一部分

英语 B 级考试解题技巧与专项训练

1 听力题解题技巧及专项训练

1.1 听力题型

高等学校英语应用能力 B 级考试已正式改革,从 2014 年 12 月起开始考试新题型。新题型最大的变化是听力理解比例增加很多,难度加大。本部分的得分占总分的 24%。测试时间为 25 分钟。听力的题目分为四个部分,各个部分的类型分别是:

Section A:听问题,选答语

这类题目要求考生在听完每个问题后,从 ABCD 四个备选项中,选出一个正确的答语。这类题型在考查中一般属于较易题,考查的重点为大纲中日常交际用语表中所列项目。如你会听到: Wish you good luck in this exam!

你会看到: A. I think so. B. Thanks a lot. C. I hope so. D. It's OK.

Section B:听对话,回答问题

这类题目让考生听一组简短的对话,在听完每则在一男一女之间进行的对话后,由第三人根据对话的内容提出一个问题,要求考生在领会谈话要旨的基础上,从卷面 ABCD 四个备选项中挑选能回答所听到问题的正确答案、或是让考生辨别说话人的职业或者两人之间的关系以及推断谈话发生的场合或地点等。如:你可能会听到以下录音:

W: I am going to London on business. Can you tell me if it rains a lot there?

M: Yes, it often rains there.

Question: What are they talking about?

你会看到四个选项:

A. Weather. B. Business. C. Season. D. Life

Section C:听简单会话,回答问题

简短会话部分有两段会话,每段会话后设置有 2~3 个问题,共 5 个问题。每个问题后面有 ABCD 四个备选项,要求考生根据所听录音,从四个选项中选出最佳答案。这部分的考点主要有时间、地点、职业身份、说话者双方的关系等。例如:你可能会听到以下两段会话及问题的录音,

看到每段会话后面 2 至 3 道题,共计 5 道题的 ABCD 选项:

Section D: 听短文, 填所缺单词

这部分是一篇 80 到 100 词之间的短文, 短文的内容大部分已出现在试卷上, 只留 5 处空白要求考生听 3 遍, 填入所缺单词或词组。如 2005 年 1 月的考生当时看到听到了以下短文:

Almost every activity in life requires communication. When you make a speech at school, 1 your food at a restaurant, or tell a joke, you are communicating. Learning to speak and express your thoughts 2 is the basic requirement of good communication. But there is 3 to speaking—one that's often neglected. That's "listening". If you don't listen, how will you know what to say when your workmate needs help or your friend is upset? So, try to remember that good communicators listen twice 4 as they speak. Maybe that's why God gave us two ears and just one 5.

1.2 解题技巧

1) 先看题后听音: 在做听力题时, 一定要做到听前先把听力试卷全部看一遍, 通过快速浏览卷面的备选答案和通篇短文, 通过对特定情景用语和短文的分析, 大概掌握和预测主题内容, 缩小听力范围;

- 2) 把握全文:听第一遍时,不要急于作答,应仔细把全文听完,尽可能弄明白文章的大意;
- 3) 边听边记:听的过程中,可以适当地做一些记录,如:时间、地点、数字、人物、天气等等,同时把可能正确的答案做上记号。
- 4) 抓关键词:无论谈话的主题是什么,总会涉及到这类主题的专门用语。抓住这个关键词,谈话地点,人物关系就好确定了。
- 5) 不因前误后:有时一个词或一个句子没有听懂,不必着急。将没听清楚的词或句子放过去,不要影响了下一道题。
- 6) 听录音过程中,必须要精力集中,专心致志;首先应整体理解录音原文的内容,弄清“六大要素”:what, who, where, when, why, how,还要侧重抓住与问题相关的情节,认真分辨近音词和同音词,以便做出正确判断。
- 7) 听完录音后,根据所听内容选择正确答案。此时可以用比较、排除等方法对选项进行合理的筛选;若对某个问题没有听清楚,可以根据本篇联系对话或短文所给出的几道理解题,进行逻辑推导,做出更符合道理的选择。千万不要留空不做。

8) 听力填空的解题技巧

听力填空题有别于阅读的填空题。听力考试中,输入大脑的信息载体为声音,因此,大家如果在背听力核心词汇的时候没有按照“四元素合一(即读音、拼写、词性、场景搭配四元素合一)”的要求去背,恐怕难以达到听力填空的要求。

所以,建议所有的学生背单词的时候,一定要做到背一个,精一个,大声的反复读(注意一定是正确的发音!否则越读越错!)这个单词刺激自己的耳朵,并配合着用手指或者笔反复的比划着该单词的拼写,务必熟练掌握词的发音、拼写、词性和场景搭配,只有这样,才能在听到复习过的听力核心词汇的时候,非常自然的把这些词正确地拼写出来,从而在紧张的听力考试中成功的应付填空题。

听写填空应注意的事项:

应快速浏览全文,根据上下文的意思及句子结构、词语搭配、习惯性用法等猜测要填的词,做到心中有数。

此题听三遍,在听第一遍时不要急于填写,而应认真听完全文,把握文章的主要大意。若时间允许,可记下所填单词的首字母;听第二遍时,填写全词。若填不出,则先搁置一旁。听第三遍时则要认真校对,如大小写、单复数、时态等各种形式都确保无误,才能做到不失分。
