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#### 内容提要

本教材结合《大学英语课程基本要求》,针对大学英语四六级听力考试让学生进行课堂练习,加大了会话听力的题量和日常交际等方面的信息,信息量大,取材广泛,内容涉及生活、学习、科技、文化、历史、教育、经济、体育等各个领域,语言生动、易懂,具有较强的实用性和针对性,旨在提高学生的听力应试技能和听说能力。



"新视角大学英语系列教材"是根据国家《大学英语课程基本要求》编写的一套系列 教材,共分为《新视角大学英语阅读教程》、《新视角大学英语听力教程》两种。

在英语学习中,听力居听、说、读、写4项基本技能之首,也是中国学生的一个难点。

突破这个难关不仅有助于其他单项技能的训练,同时也为培养学生的英语实际能力奠定一个良好的基础。国家教委最近颁布的《大学英语教学大纲》对大学生的听力方面应达到的标准做出了详细规定。本套听力教程就是按照这个大纲的要求,根据中国大学英语教学的特点编写的新型听力教材。

本教程信息量大,取材广泛,内容涉及生活、学习、科技、文化、历史、教育、经济、体育等各个领域,语言生动、易懂,具有较强的实用性和针对性。

本教程共4册,每学期1册,每册10个单元,每单元包括4个部分,之后又附有听力全真模拟题。

本教程结合《大学英语课程基本要求》,加大了会话听力的题量和日常交际等方面的信息,相信学生会受益匪浅。本教材单元练习及模拟题都配有录音光盘。录音材料由美籍专家朗读,语音纯正,声音清晰。

本套教材由东北师范大学刘永兵教授和吉林大学刘淑范教授担任总主审,东北师范 大学高瑛教授和长春工程学院唐艳玲教授担任总主编。本书主编各负责编写5万字,副主 编各负责编写2.65万字。


