谨将这本双色版英汉双解词典,奉献给我们初中、高中、大学(非英语专业)的勤勉学友们! 也奉献给同等水平的各行各业的从业人士!

本词典收录的英语词汇共一万多条,无论是对 莘莘学子,或是对孜孜不倦的上班族而言,在学习、翻译、交谈、阅读各个领域,均可从容应对。

本词典所有词条、短语和例句,都一一英汉双解,目的是引导读者步入英语语境,体味英语单词的确切含义和实际用法,使读友们说英语可滔滔不绝于口,译英语则可贴切准确无误。

本词典注重时尚性,对近几年来各门各类出现的新词新义,但凡需要又适用者,从国际货币基金组织(IMF)到网络、网虫,从冲浪运动到超市,从浏览器到激光视盘,均予收录。

为给读者记忆英语单词助一臂之力,编者特意 在正文之后编录了三个附件,将英语常见词根、前 缀、后缀以及同义词、反义词——列出,这样,读友们 记忆英语单词的时间和烦恼可大大减少,而学会、学 好英语的信念则会倍增。
