

## 一起啊一啊

# 读故事

- 孩子朗读时,您要认真听,让孩子有信心读下去。如果碰到不熟悉的单词,可以让孩子 多花一点儿时间进行拼读。
- 读到第2页和第4页时,让孩子注意一下单词 Mr 和 Mrs,给孩子解释这两个单词的不同。
- 读到第 4~5 页时,让孩子说一说,故事中的孩子们为什么要保持安静。
- 读到第 6 页时,将单词 Aneesa 中的字母 sa 遮起来,让孩子试着拼读前面的部分。之后再试着拼读整个单词。
- 读完第6页,问孩子: Why was Mr Bell cross?
- 读完第 19 页,问孩子: Was Tom naughty to feed the ducks?
- 读完第 20 页,问孩子:Why did the geese run after Tom?
- 读完第 23 页,问孩子: Why wasn't Mr Bell cross with Aneesa?






