

THE STORY OF GUINNESS

The 55-year history of Guinness World Records began with a single question, the type of question that has been repeated millions of times at restaurants, kitchen tables, classrooms and work places across the globe.

During a shooting party in County Wexford, Ireland, in 1951, Sir Hugh Beaver – then Managing Director of the Guinness Brewery – asked a simple question: what was Europe's fastest game bird? Despite a heated argument and an exhaustive search within the host's reference library he could not find the answer.

Sir Hugh realized that similar questions were going unanswered all around the world, and that a definitive book containing superlative facts and answers would be of great use to the general public. With the help of the London-based fact-finding twins Norris and Ross McWhirter, he soon set about bringing this definitive collection of superlative facts to reality. On 27 August 1955, the first edition of "The Guinness Book of Records" was bound and, by Christmas that year, became Britain's number one bestseller.

Today, the Guinness World Records book is a publishing phenomenon, sold in 26 languages,

吉尼斯的故事

《吉尼斯世界纪录大全》已有 55 年的历史,它来源于一个人们在茶余饭后、学习工作期间反复讨论的问题。

1951年,在爱尔兰韦克斯福德郡 (County Wexford) 的一次狩猎聚会上,当时的英国吉尼斯啤酒公司执行董事休 · 比佛 (Hugh Beaver) 爵士提出疑问:欧洲飞得最快的鸟是什么? 经过一番激烈争论,也翻遍了图书馆的资料,但他始终没有找到答案。

比佛爵士意识到,这些问题还没有人能回答,如果有一本书能为这类"争论"提供答案的话,公众将受益匪浅。当时,有一对孪生兄弟诺里斯·麦克沃特(Norris Mcwhiter)和罗斯·麦克沃特(Ross Mcwhiter)在伦敦开了一家实况调查公司,在他们的帮助下,比佛爵士迅速开始收集资料。1955年8月27日,第一本《吉尼斯世界纪录大全》装订成册,当年圣诞节前夕,该书即荣登







Largest doline 最大的岩溶漏斗

Xiao Zhai Tian Keng (The Great Doline) is the largest doline in the world. Situated in Sichuan Province of central southern China, this huge depression measures 500 m (1,600 ft) across and 660 m (2,165 ft) deep. Dolines are formed when limestone caves subside.

Deepest valley 最深的峡谷

The Yarlung Zangbo Valley in Tibet of China has an average depth of 5,000 m (16,400 ft), but explorers in 1994 discovered that its deepest point was 5,382 m (17,657 ft). The peaks of Namche Barwa (7,753 m, 25,436 ft) and Jala Peri (7,282 m, 23,891 ft) are just 21 km (13 miles) apart with the Yarlung Zangbo River between them, at an elevation of 2,440 m (8,000 ft).

Highest river 海拔最高的河流

Of the major rivers of the world the highest one is the Yarlung Zangbo, which rises in Tibet of China, and runs for around 2,000 km (1,242 miles) in China, with an average elevation of around 4 km (2.4 miles), before entering India, where it is known as the Brahmaputra River. It enters the ocean at the Bay of Bengal, where it forms the world's largest delta.

Largest river to dry up 最大的断流河

THE REPORT OF THE PARTY OF THE

The Yellow River (Huang He) is China's second longest river and is one of the greatest rivers of the world. For several months a year the 5,460 km (3,390 mile) river now dries up in Henan Province some 400 km (250 miles) before it reaches the sea.

Loudest singing sands 最响的沙漠

The world's loudest singing sands are at Mingshashan Mountain in western China. Recalling the noise made by a drum or a low-flying jet, their sounds are audible from as far away as 10 km (32,808 ft), can be as loud as 105 decibels, and exhibit a frequency of 95-105 hertz. The mechanism responsible for their sounds, however, remains controversial, but is believed to rely upon the sands' degree of wetness, as dry sands do not sing.



Longest river with its entire drainage system in one country 流域在一国的最长河流

The longest river that has its entire drainage system within one country is the Yangtze River of China which measures 6,397 km (3,975 miles) long - the third longest river in the world, and the longest in Asia. The Yangtze River, as it is also known, has its headwaters in the glaciers of the Qinghai-Tibetan Plateau, heads eastwards across China and empties into the East China Sea.

Highest living fish 最高处生存的鱼

The highest living fish is the Tibetan loach (family Cobitidae), found at an altitude of 5,200 m (17,060 ft) in the Himalayas.

Highest living mammal 生活在海拔最高处的哺乳动物

The highest-living mammal in the world is the large-eared pika (Ochtona macrotis), which has been recorded at a height of 6,130 m (20,112 ft) in high-altitude mountain ranges in Asia. The yak (Bos mutus) of Tibet and the Sichuanese Alps, China, climbs to an altitude of 6,100 m (20,013 ft) when foraging.

Highest and lowest desert 海拔最高和最低的沙漠

The People's Republic of China contains both the highest desert - the Qaidam Depression, which is 2,600 m (8,530 ft) above sea level, and the lowest desert, the Turpan Depression, which is 150 m (492 ft) below sea level.

海拔最高的沙漠,是中国的柴达木坳陷,海拔2,600米;海拔最低的沙漠,是中国的吐鲁番坳陷,低于海拔150米。

Heaviest panda cub born in captivity 出生时最重的饲养熊猫

The heaviest panda cub born in captivity weighed 218 g (7.6 oz) when he was born at the Wolong Giant Panda Research Centre, Chengdu, Sichuan Province, China on 7th August 2006. The cub is the first offspring of panda Zhang Ka, who was in labour for 34 hours itself, the longest recorded labour for a captive panda.
