序 言

华东师范大学第二附属中学

在教育改革不断深化的过程中，高考也在逐步改革。就高考科目而言，全国大多数地区将实行“3+2”（有的地区，如上海，是“3+1”）。这就是说，语文、数学、外语是共同的必考科目，考文科类专业的考生要加考政治、历史两科，考理科类专业的考生则加考物理、化学两科。凡有愿望和条件参加高考的高三毕业生，都得通过5门学科的考试，才可能被择优选拔进入高等学校。

高中教育仍属基础教育的范畴，高中生应在德、智、体诸方面都得到生动活泼的发展，全面提高素质。社会不要求每一个高中毕业生都考入高校，也不可能让每一个高中毕业生都进入高校。但是，社会希望那些全面提高了素质，并有志于提高学历层次的高中毕业生参加高考，也设法创造条件以尽可能多地吸收高中毕业生到高校继续学习，成为祖国社会主义建设的有用之才。因此，准备参加高考的高中毕业生，理应认真备考，力争考出自己的最高水平。从一定意义上说，这也是衡量高中毕业生素质提高状况的一个重要方面。

为了适应高考改革的发展态势，帮助高中毕业年级学生复习迎考，上海科学技术出版社约请上海中学、华东师范大学第二附属中学、复旦大学附属中学的部分教师编写《高考指导“3+2”丛书》（包括语文、数学、英语、政治、历史、物理、化学七个分册），确是一项有意义的举措。高中毕业生如果要参加高考，自然离不开所在学校老师的辛勤指导，更需要自己的刻苦努力，同时也会期望得到一种有参考价值的阅读材料。过去，这类材料有不少版本。现在，这套“3+2”丛书则是实行“3+2”高考后编成的首种新的参考书。

读一读这套丛书，读者就会发现：这不是烦琐的高考习题汇集，也不是单纯地对高中教材中知识内容作一般性复述和解说。作者编写这套丛书，是以中学各科教学大纲和高考考纲为依据的，同时还兼顾各地多本教材的内容要求，吸收这些教材内容的长处和特点。由此，丛书的适应面就较广泛，能供各地参照使用。在这套丛书中，既有反映各学科基础知识的内容，又在此基础上略有提高，作为一种最低要求；也有提高各学科知识解析能力的内容，作为一般要求；还有提高各学科知识综合应用能力的内容，作为较高一层的要求。在各学科分册中，一般都有该学科知识要点的整理，有对其中重点和难点的说明，有例题列举并作解题分析，有按单元(或课)编拟的单元练习或综合测试题，最后都附有若干种高考模拟试卷。综观这套丛书后，我相信，对高三年级的学生(包括参加“3+2”和“3+1”高考的考生)会有所助益的，对高三年级的教师也可能会有有一定的启发作用。

据了解，参加编写这套丛书的作者都是三校的高三有教学经验的教师，有的分册还约请其他有专长的同志撰写部分文稿或提供资料。他们花费了近10个月的时间，付出了极大的心血，才得以使这套有质量的新丛书问世。但是，书编得再好，也还需读者会读书、会用书。我希望，这套丛书能在善读善用书的读者手中发挥积极作用，帮助他们在高考中取得理想的成绩。同时，也希望通过善思考的读者提出意见，帮助作者进一步完善丛书的内容，提高丛书的质量。上海科学技术出版社为了更好地指导复习，本丛书中的语文、数学、外语三门必考科还配有录象带。

最后，请允许我利用写序言的机会，祝愿那些有志于参加高考的高中毕业生，能在勤奋求知的过程中实现自己的意愿。
