# 前言

出道 15 年以来, 我教过课、写过书, 一直口碑还不错, 每天都会有一批又一批的小伙伴组团扑向我的微信或微博, 问候、感谢、困惑、疑问、惊喜、喜讯、红包……满屏飞, 承蒙烤鸭们的厚爱, 在此一并谢过。

一个初出茅庐的雅思小白,经过练级、快速通关,最终成为一代雅思大神,接受后人膜拜,这几乎是每一个烤鸭梦寐以求的事情。问世间,雅思能否"速成"?美国心理学巨匠威廉·詹姆斯有一段经典注释:"种下一个行动,收获一种行为;种下一种行为,收获一种习惯;种下一种习惯,收获一种性格;种下一种性格,收获一种命运。"

雅思"速成"就是要有一颗时刻想着雅思的心,也就是要养成一种顺应雅思考试的思维习惯。而一个习惯的养成通常需要21天,需要经过以下三个阶段:

#### 第一个阶段是第 1—7 天

这个阶段的特征是"刻意、不自然"。面对雅思各单项的题目,烤鸭们需要十分刻意地提醒自己改变之前的做题方式,起初可能会觉得有些不自然、不舒服,别担心,认真做好备考规划,克服这些情况。

#### 第二个阶段是第8—14天

这个阶段的特征是"刻意、自然", 烤鸭们在面对雅思各单项的题目时, 已经觉得比较自然, 比较舒服了, 但是一不留意, 还会恢复到以前的思维方式, 因此, 还需要刻意地提醒自己改变。

#### 第三个阶段是第 15-21 天

这个阶段的特征是"不刻意、自然",其实这就是习惯,这一阶段被称为"习惯性的稳定期"。一旦跨入这个阶段,基本上就已经完成了自我改造。这个习惯已成为你生命中一个有机的组成部分,它会自然而然地为你效劳。

9分烤鸭之路,从制定一个良好的备考规划开始,初出茅庐的烤鸭们可将雅思备考规划分成上述三个阶段,每个阶段7天,将《9分烤鸭·雅思真题解析》系列图书作为备考书籍合理使用,按照规划路径,严格执行,假以时日,方能大成。
