序言 Foreword

2015年是世界反法西斯战争暨中国人民抗日战争胜利70周年。为了铭记历史、缅怀先烈、珍视和平、警示未来,特出版《二战中的国际大屠杀与民众受难》画册。

本画册分为四部分:第二次世界大战的爆发;日本军国主义在二战中的暴行;德意法西斯在二战中的暴行;战后德日对大屠杀历史态度的比较。通过近200幅历史图片,真实地再现了第二次世界大战给全世界民众带来的灾难。

历史是一面镜子。回顾惨痛的历史是为了获得开创和平未来的智慧和启迪。本画册旨在再次唤醒人们的良知,呼吁有识之士共同维护历史真相,以史为鉴,不让历史悲剧重演,让人类永续沐浴在和平的阳光之下。

2015 is the 70th anniversary of the world's anti-Fascism war and Chinese people's war against Japanese invasion. We publish this special album *International Massacres and People's Sufferings During the Second World War*, so that people today will recall the history, remember the victims and martyrs, cherish the peaceful life today and learn from the past lessons to ensure a bright future.

This album is divided into four parts: "the Outbreak of the Second World War" "the Atrocities of Japanese Militarism in the Second World War" "Atrocities Committed by German and Italian Fascists During the Second World War" "Attitudes of Germany and Japan Toward Their War Atrocities in Postwar Years". Through more than 200 historic pictures, the album authentically represents the sufferings of the people across the world during the Second World War.

History is a mirror. We review the painful history in order to create a peaceful future. The main goal of this album is to awaken people's conscience, and appeal to people of all countries to acknowledge the facts of history, so that the tragic events will not occur again and people will live in peace in future.

The first half of the 20th century witnessed the outbreak of two world wars. The Second World War is the largest war in scale and loss in human history. The flames of war spread to 60 countries in Europe and Asia, as well as the Atlantic Ocean, the Pacific Ocean and the Mediterranean Sea. Billions of people were drawn into the war, and innumerable people were massacred and abused. The war brought about an enormous disaster to human beings.

第二次世界大战的序幕

The Prelude of the Second World War

第一次世界大战后,不甘战败的德国和对分赃不满的意大利和日本,要求重新瓜分世界。20世纪30年代的世界经济大萧条,给资本主义国家以沉重打击。为了摆脱危机,意大利、德国、日本先后走上了法西斯化道路,扩军备战,在欧洲和亚洲形成了两个世界战争策源地,第二次世界大战一触即发。

After the First World War, Germany did not accept defeat. Meanwhile, Italy and Japan were not satisfied with what they had gained from the war. They wanted to divide up the world again. In the 1930s, the Great Depression hit the capitalist world. In order to walk out of their crises, Italy, Germany and Japan successively accepted Fascism as their national policy and started to enlarge military forces. A world war was about to break in Europe and Asia.

After the First World War, the Italian economy was in depression and its society was in chaos. The National Fascist Party caught this opportunity to rise. On October 30, 1922, Benito Mussolini was nominated as Prime Minister and the Fascist dictatorship was established. From then on, Italy went on the road of aggression.



1935年10月2日,意大利入侵埃塞俄比亚,对埃军阵地和无辜平民进行狂轰滥炸,包括英国和瑞典红十字会战地医院在内的多家医院被摧毁,后意军还在战争中使用毒气。

On October 2,1935, Italy invaded Ethiopia. Italian army dropped bombs on Ethiopian army and civilians. Many hospitals were destroyed, including British and Swedish Red Cross hospitals. Besides, the Italian army used poisonous gas in the war.
