【内容简介】 本书旨在为四级英语考生应考前提供一本针对性极强的词汇习题集,使考生的词汇量在考前有较大的增长与巩固。本书采用词频理论和实验方法从大学英语教学大纲 4 000 词中选出 800 个较难单词并以此编写成词汇习题。全书共分 16 单元,每个单元 50 题。书末附有重点单词注解及答案。由于本书选词均是有一定难度的常用词,故本书亦适用于其他类型考生。

前 言

词汇学习与积累是英语学习中极为重要的组成部分。根据调查,目前绝大部分四级考试应考生对大纲词汇表所规定的单词仍有 500~1 000 个不熟悉或不认识。词汇量偏小是造成考生应考失败的重要原因之一。本书的编写旨在为考生考前提供一本针对性极强的练习材料,使考生对一些较难单词有熟悉、巩固的机会,同时使考生的词汇量在较短的时间内有较大的增长。

本书是根据词频理论对大学英语教学大纲中(理工科)的 4 000 个单词进行筛选,并用实验进行验证,最后再根据多位教师的教学经验作适当的调整,选出 800 个对大学二年级学生具有一定难度且对阅读会造成障碍的单词。并以此编写成练习,供四级应考者作考前训练使用。

本书每 50 题编为一个单元,共 16 单元。全书分为两个部分。第一部分从 Test 1~Test 7,主要以熟练巩固为主,兼顾扩大词汇量(该部分由 350 个单词组成)。第一部分的句子和选择项所用单词控制在四级词汇范围内。第二部分从 Test 8~Test 16,主要以扩大词汇量为主(该部分由 450 个单词组成)。该部分句子所用单词亦控制在四级词汇范围内,而在选择项中增加了部分在阅读中极为常见,且被列入大纲六级词汇表的单词。本书所选用单词义项均属大纲指定义项范围。同时,书末附有重点单词的简略注释。

本书可作为大学英语四级考试考生的考前强化训练材料。由于本书所选单词均是具有一定难度的常用词,故本书亦适用于其他类型考生。

本书由西安石油学院闫传海、张梅娟主编,西北工业大学外语系张庭季教授审校。参加本书部分编写工作的还有张正辉、余运学、丁柏青。

限于作者水平,错误难免,敬请读者指正。
